## Smart Specialisation in Italy: regional and national dimension



21 Regional S3s

5 Less Developed - GDP $<75 \%$ EU27 avg

3 In Transition $-75 \%=<$ GDP $<90 \%$ EU27 avg
13 More Developed - GDP > 90\% EU27 avg

A heterogeneous picture of how each of the Regions defined their S3.

## The 21 regional S3s

- Regions are characterized by different:
- levels of administrative abilities;
- implementation structures;
- levels of experience in managing R\&I policies.
- Regional S3s were approved with different timing (from 2014 to 2017)
- different stages
- different needs to revise their strategies


## Different stages of S3s

- All the regions planned to have a mid term revision in 2018/2019

To date:

- Valle D'Aosta, Lombardia, Friuli have already revised
- Emilia Romagna, Toscana, Umbria have begun the updating process

## Final considerations

- Experimental exercice: up to now it has been implemented in only 2 regions, Sicily and Umbria
- Sicily is a less developed region and it is still working on the preconditions (governance and monitoring), even if has planned the S3 revision in 2019.
- Umbria is classified as a region more developed, the S3 of Umbria was approved in 2014, now they are revising their strategy and they have a good governance structure.
- This instrument will be gradually introduced in all the regions
- Territories need taxonomies and standards: they must be free to make their strategic choices, but once they have made them, they need clear and standardized instruments and codes to refer to.
