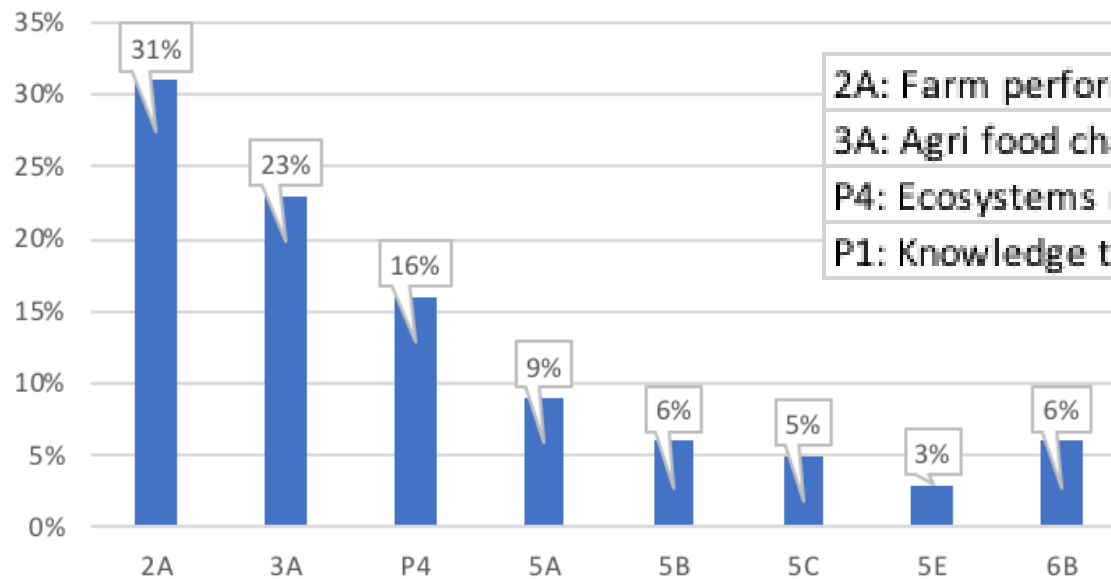

PT Rural development programme

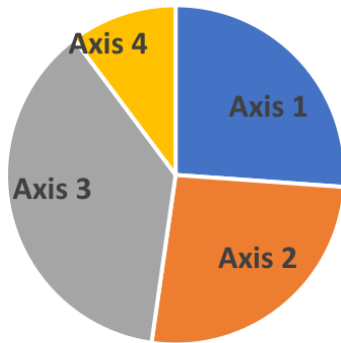
M16 Cooperation
