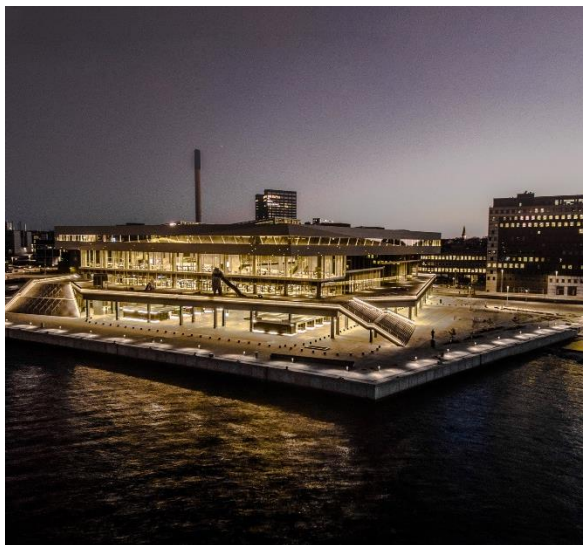


Innovation Camp: We work with challenges

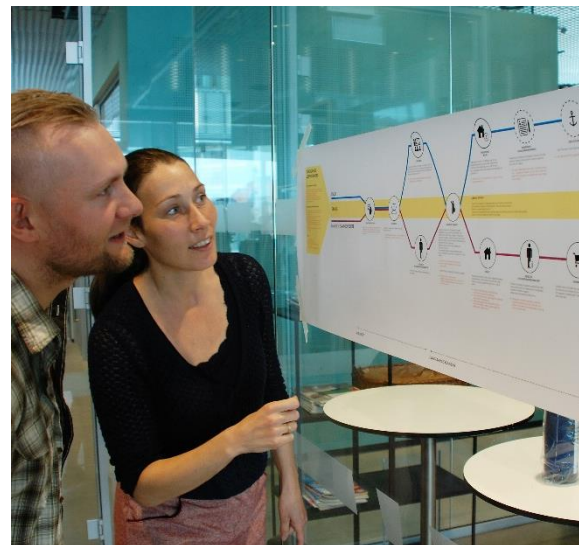
