

Regional context RIS3 and DIH


RIS3CAT Action Plan: more than 400 MEUR from ERDF to support Catalonia's smart specialisation and to transform knowledge and technology into economic and social value


- Is it the ecosystem of actors providing digital technologies/services to companies?

Challenges RIS3 -DIH


- At this moment the discussion is about how to "organize" the multiple existing initiatives
 and services into a Catalan DIH with to aims: to facilitate access to companies and to
 improve the capacity to get funds from European competitive calls.
- It is necessary to design and implement a common "structure" with a governance to "organise" and "visualise" the digital technological capacities and services (the ecosystem).
- It is necessary to combine bottom-up and top-down approaches







- Funding from ERDF under the RIS3CAT.










Catalonia's DIH ecosystem of Big Data (draft)

Catalonia's DIH ecosystem of textile (draft)


















