The European Commission's White Paper on the Future of Europe¹ and its Start-up and Scale-up Communication² outlined the need for more industrial cooperation and strategic connections between regional and local eco-systems. Its recent Communication on 'Strengthening Innovation in Europe's Regions'³ also calls for stronger strategic inter-regional cooperation, sustainable linkages and investments.

This second edition of **#GROWyourREGIOn**⁴ takes place when lessons are drawn on how smart specialisation strategies, the European Structural Investment Funds and clusters can support resilient, inclusive and sustainable growth in Europe's regions.

#GROWyour REGIOn is an opportunity to:

- share your smart specialisation and cluster experience and practices;
- exchange ideas about future actions for smart interregional collaboration;
- learn about novel ways of supporting innovation and accelerating industrial modernisation and SME growth.

This conference gathers over 300 national and regional authorities that manage ERDF and INTERREG projects, the business community and cluster stakeholders engaged in European cluster partnerships and cluster projects. Participants will discuss novel ways to boosting smart interregional collaboration through clusters towards more European "Silicon Valleys" and value chain linkages that bring benefits to regions and cities across Europe.

#GROWyourREGIOn is a conference with a difference. Participants will not just be listening to inspiring practice cases and speakers, but are invited to actively contribute, collaborate and co-create. It aims to gather ideas and proposals for the programming period post-2020 as a follow-up to the Smart Regions conference⁵ and the Communication on 'Strengthening Innovation in Europe's Regions'. This shall serve also as an input for the next European Industry Day in February 2018.⁶
