
# What is TAIEX-REGIO PEER 2 PEER?

# Who can apply?




"International exchange" – with other Member States (*not* between regions/bodies *within* the country)




# **Implementation: key statistics**

#### **Examples of exchanges on smart specialisation (1)**

#### **Romanian-Dutch regional co-operation**

Who? Regions of North East Romania and Northern Netherlands

Aim? to set up to joint programme based on RIS-3 principles and develop a show case for the European interregional S3-cooperation

How? A round of PEER 2 PEER study visits and workshops to:

- map the value chains
- generate business models
- involve key regional partners
- develop a programme for longer-term co-operation




