

## **RDI** in the Hungarian Operational Programmes

TO1 interventions are supported by

- EDIOP PA2: 1,434 m EUR
- EDIOP PA8 (FIs): 620 m EUR
- CCHOP PA1&2: 98 m EUR



- CCHOP - Competitive Central Hungary OP

#### **Synergies with H2020 was explicitly targeted during programming:**

Measure 2.3 Creation of R&I capacities to generate excellence


**Specific objective:** Increasing **Horizon 2020 participation** by strengthening the R&I capacities - among the publicly funded and non-profit research entities.

"Joining international excellence cooperation (in particular: Horizon 2020) at an increasing volume as a result of strengthening R&D capacities is of fundamental importance; as a total impact, excellence in research should increase."

Result indicator: Number of Hungarian participants in Horizon 2020 Framework Programme



## Combining H2020 & ESIF through funding of <u>successive</u> / <u>parallel</u> / <u>particular</u> projects





#### In fact, the **EDIOP explicitly targets to reach synergies in the widest sense**:

- "In order to exploit synergies between Horizon 2020 and ESIF funds it will be <u>allowed</u> to combine Horizon2020 and ESIF funding in the same project provided that there is no double funding in the same expenditure item."
- "there are specific measures foreseen to use ESIF funds for the preparation phase of <u>Horizon 2020 projects</u> and for the <u>follow-up of successful H2020 projects</u> allowing the participants to utilize their research results"
- "we also intend to support participation in the programmes that belong to the instruments [of Horizon 2020] aimed at <u>Widening Participation</u> and promote those organizations which participate in high-quality H2020 proposals ranked <u>above</u> <u>threshold but failing to get H2020 funding</u> due to lack of available budget."
- "The objective of supporting the development of international R&D relationships is to enhance Hungary's participation in some <u>international programmes and joint initiatives</u> <u>of the EU</u> and the Member States" (JPIs, Art. 185. initiatives, JTIs or ERA-NETs)
- <u>Capacity building</u>: ELI and other research infrastructures

# However, <u>HU also has to ensure synergies between its National RDI Fund and ESIFs!</u> (especially because the serious capital region problem)
