Knowledge Transfer in Action – Instruments for interregional Learning

How can innovative regional development approaches be transferred between regions? Which role do public authorities, companies, universities, and civil actors play in this context?

For three years public authorities, technology park managers and scientists from six European regions have been cooperating in answering these questions – at the Know-Man International Conference we will share and discuss our findings with you!

On 25 October 2012, the Know-Man Project will present its rich portfolio of instruments for interregional learning – from a targeted demand analysis and a benchmarking of existing services to the visualization of knowledge in regions. Together with academic experts and practitioners, the regional and European relevance of these findings will be discussed. Last but not least, we offer a first glimpse towards the new Structural Funds funding period. We will shed some light on Smart Specialization and the development of the new operational programmes and discuss in how far lessons learned in Know-Man might help to develop ideas for future initiatives.

The conference addresses practitioners working at the science – economy – policy interface searching for tools, instruments and strategies to better link and support knowledge exchange among these spheres.
