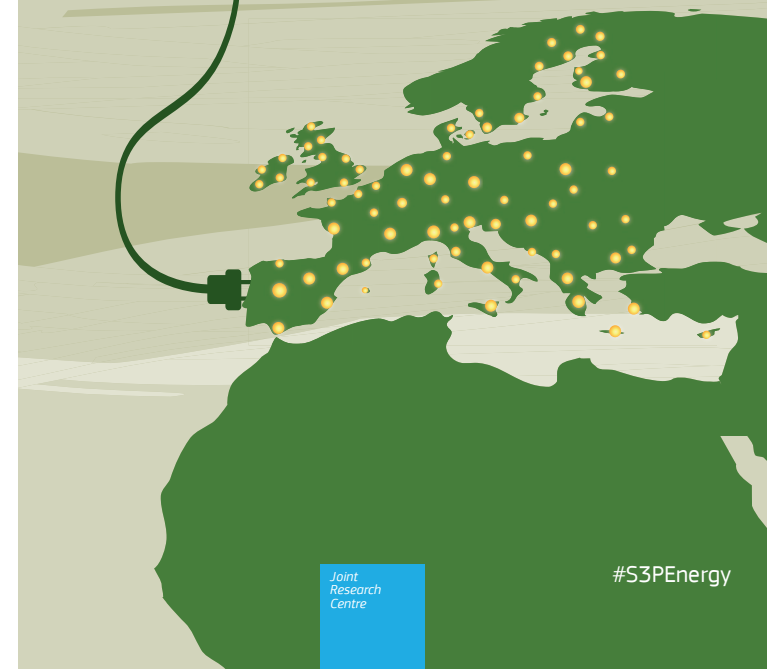
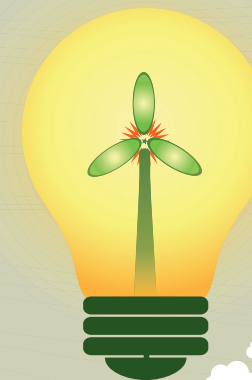

The **Smart Specialisation Platform on Energy (S3PEnergy)** is the space where Member States, regions and community members receive support for the optimal and effective uptake of Cohesion Funds for sustainable energy.

The **S3PEnergy** also promotes energy innovation activities at national, regional and local level through the identification of technologies and innovative solutions that support, in the most cost-effective way, the EU energy policy priorities.
