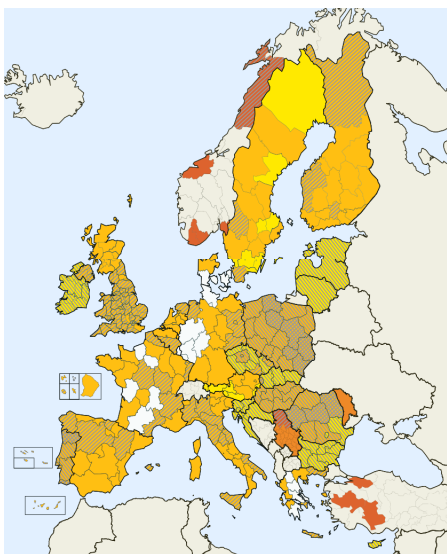




S3 PLATFORM MEMBERSHIP REGISTERED COUNTRIES AND REGIONS
