Bulgarian ICT Cluster Initiative

- Established in 2005, as national wide cluster initiative in field of ICT.
- ICT cluster society has 10+ members: 7 vertical sector clusters with 300+ SME's, 3 sector associations, 6 technical universities.
- In 2014 Bulgarian ICT cluster initiated establishment of ***Balkan and Black Sea ICT clusters network*** and was its first leading organization. Today network is recognized on EU level and represents 18 organizations from 11 countries.
- Proven experience with H2020, COSME, Danube Strategy projects, Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs. Member of national Business Council, supporting Council of Ministry in policy making, building road maps and implementation.



Policy level impact

How can regional authorities influence funding efficiencies in countries with strong central governments?

- Continuously training managing authorities staff (competence in programming, monitoring); Sustainable program for development & supports of scientific and research facilities; Use of PPP collaboration in all phases, but especially in phase of monitoring of every program/call impact & results.

What is the role of Regional policies in the implementation EU policies to promote research and innovation?

- To promote & use EU level of tools (SoE, Cluster labeling system); To bias Regional support programs with RIS3; to support commercialization via TTO



Bottlenecks & Barriers

- Mobile, strong and knowledgeable research community; Platform for real time cooperation among triple helix actors; National support organizations; Rising media coverage for best cases;
- Lack of understanding of trends on global markets;

- Continuous training instruments for SME & research society; Further improvement of evaluation system;

- Short horizon political view and/or political instability; Lack of coordination on national level thus overlapping among different instruments; Economical instability and high level of brain drain;

- To compensate low level of R&I investments; To rectify direction of research & development keeping in focus global market opportunities and threats;
