S3 PEER-REVIEW

S3 Platform 11th Peer-review workshop

26-27 September in Heraklion (GR)

The S3 Platform and the Greek region of Crete are pleased to announce the organisation of the S3 Platform's 11th peer-review workshop in the city of Heraklion. The workshop will include a session on **RIS3 and green growth**, including the role of ICT and smart specialisation.

Five regions (Castilla y León (Spain), Crete (Greece), Moravia-Silesia (Czech Republic), Nordland (Norway) and Umbria (Italy)) will present their current work on RIS3. The other workshop participants will be asked to act as 'critical friends' and discuss the strategies of the four regions under review.

The workshop is also going to include a plenary discussion on the application of the concept of related variety to RIS3, led by Prof. Ron Boschma, Director of the Centre for Innovation, Research and Competence in the Learning Economy (CIRCLE) at Lund University in Sweden.

OPEN DAYS 2013 – 11th EUROPEAN WEEK OF REGIONS AND CITIES

In October 2013, regions and cities will be finalising preparations for the 2014-2020 cohesion policy, rural development and fisheries programmes. The OPEN DAYS will offer EU institutions, managing authorities and final beneficiaries a chance to exchange and network on new approaches before the new operational programmes are implemented in 2014. Regions and cities will also be able to present the results of their 2007-2013 EU-funded programmes and projects, showcasing the impact these have on regional development, i.e. contributing to smart, sustainable and inclusive growth.

In the framework the OPEN DAYS and in the context of the S3 Platform's work on the role of universities in smart specialisation, a workshop will be co-hosted with DG Education and Culture in association with the European University Association **on 9 October 2013 in Brussels**. The workshop will be one of many workshops addressing regional innovation at the OPEN DAYS.

RIS3 AND RURAL AREAS: A THEMATIC WORKSHOP

RIS3 are placed based economic development strategies and one of the defining features of many places are the rural or peri-rural contexts. In order to explore the theme of rurality and smart specialisation further, the S3 Platform has accepted the invitation of Centro region in Portugal to host a **workshop on 22-23 October 2013**. Participants will be met at Lisbon airport and transferred to the hotel and meeting venue. The agenda will be based on participatory methods such as World Café that have been used widely in S3 Platform events, allowing a complete exploration of the theme. Furthermore, the results of the workshop will lead to an S3 Policy Brief to be circulated among EU, national and regional policy makers and practitioners.

RIS3 IN THE BALTIC SEA REGION

Get smarter together in the Baltic Sea Region – taking innovation and smart specialisation across borders

On 6 and 7 November 2013 in Malmö, Sweden, the S3 Platform together with BSR Stars, StarDust and Vinnova, will organise an event to find cooperation partners and exploit the synergies between the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region and the RIS3s in the same area. The event will offer concrete opportunities to add a cross-border dimension to the development of Smart Specialisation by matching interesting partner regions with the aim at achieving something that they cannot do on their own. Matchmaking will be concentrated around identified common topics, for example Personal Health and Sustainable Cities. On November 6th, results of StarDust will be presented and discussed in relation to how to create strong competitive advantages in the macro-region. The events aim at gathering representatives among innovative companies, clusters, universities, innovation agencies and other actors involved in development and implementation of Smart Specialisation Strategies around the Baltic Sea.

HIGH-LEVEL EVENT: REGIONS AS NEW MOTORS OF GROWTH THROUGH SMART SPECIALISATION

The Directorate-General for Regional and Urban Policy of the European Commission and the Flemish Government invite you to discuss the new growth opportunities and transformation powers of regional smart specialisation, in particular in view of the multi-level governance challenges of the European growth and re-industrialisation agendas.

At this crucial moment smart specialisation strategies are about to be launched across Europe mobilising a large number of stakeholders and leveraging public and private funds for innovation.

This high-level event will take place **on 8 November 2013 in Brussels** and will present the state of the art of smart specialisation and discuss its implications for European competitiveness, economic policy making and governance in the search for new growth opportunities.

It will also aim at stimulating processes of mapping and combining national, regional and European innovation roadmaps through a series of thematic workshops focusing on specific areas of joint opportunity linked to common societal challenges.
