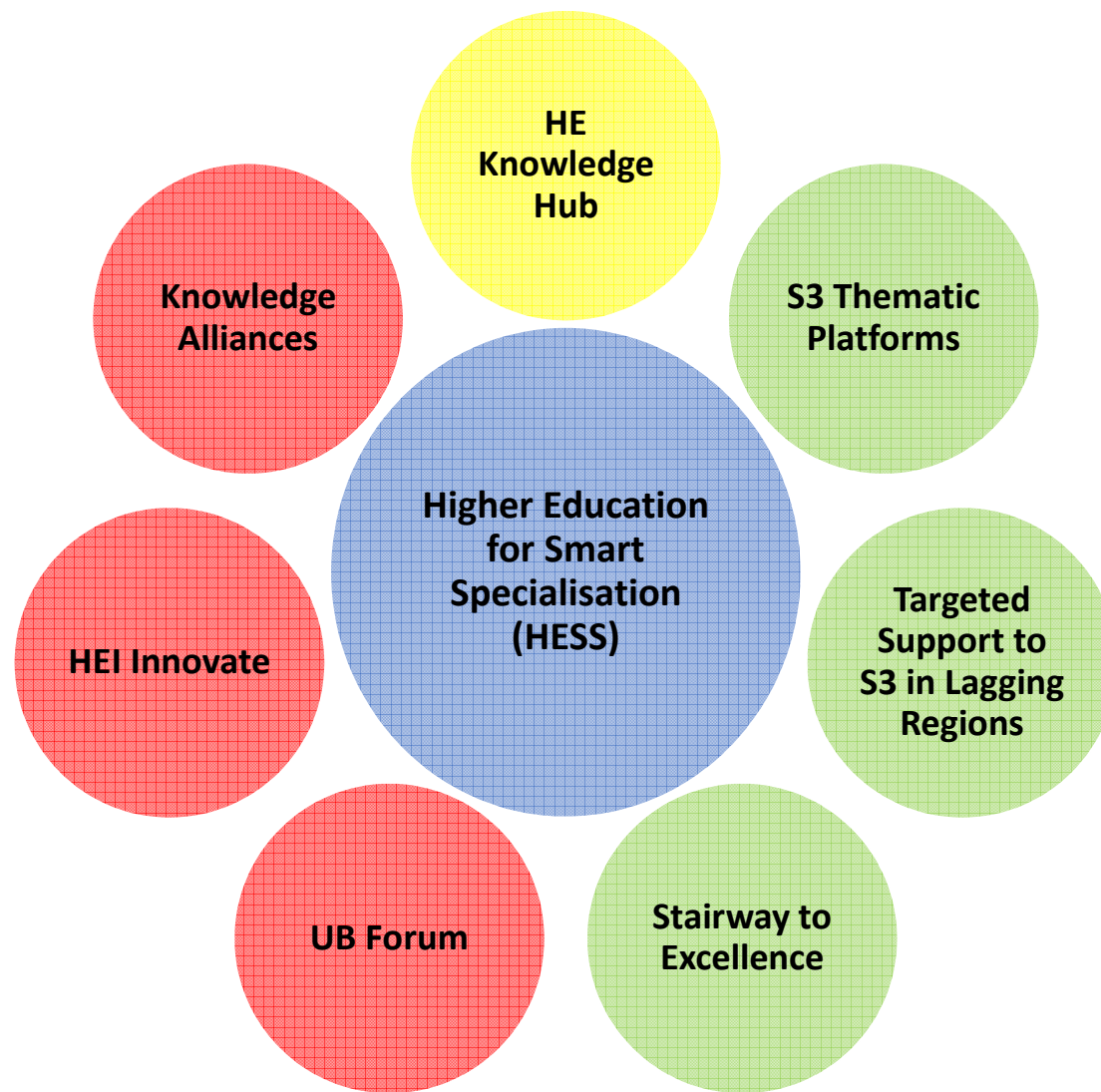

Entrepreneurial Process of Discovery (EDP)	Horizontal skills among graduates Monitoring and role of social sciences
Prioritisation / critical mass	Curricula and research evolution 'Third mission' redefinition
Innovation for all regions – Place based approach	Embedded in regional governance Different models and tools for engagement
Broader understanding of innovation	More applied and interdisciplinary research Respond to regional challenges

HESS Objectives

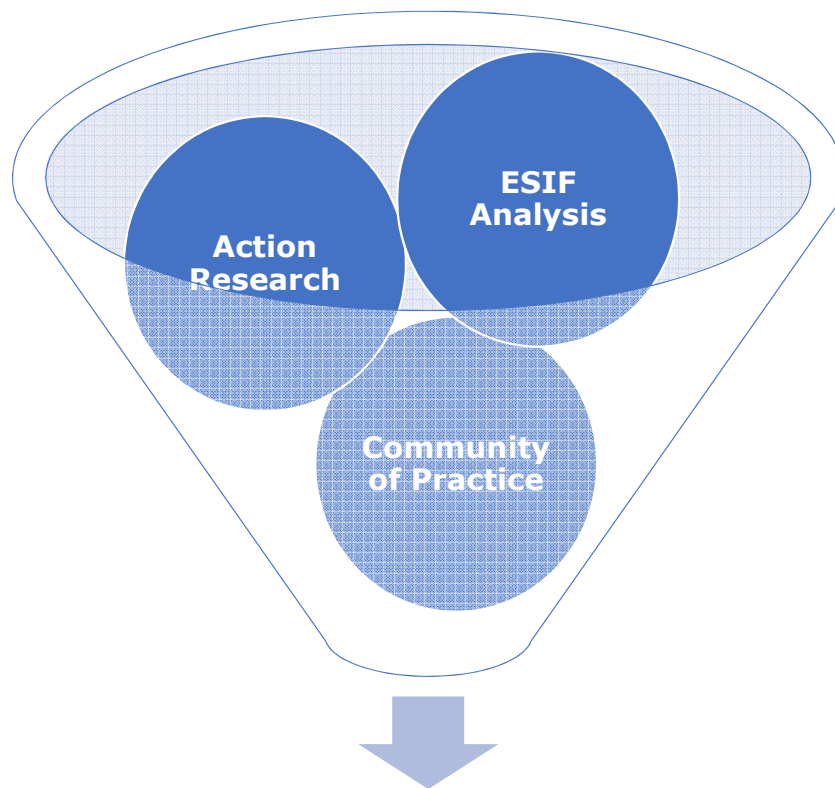
Core Objectives

- Promote synergetic use of ESIF and other public funds to incentivise HEIs
- Strengthen the position of HEIs in S3 governance structures

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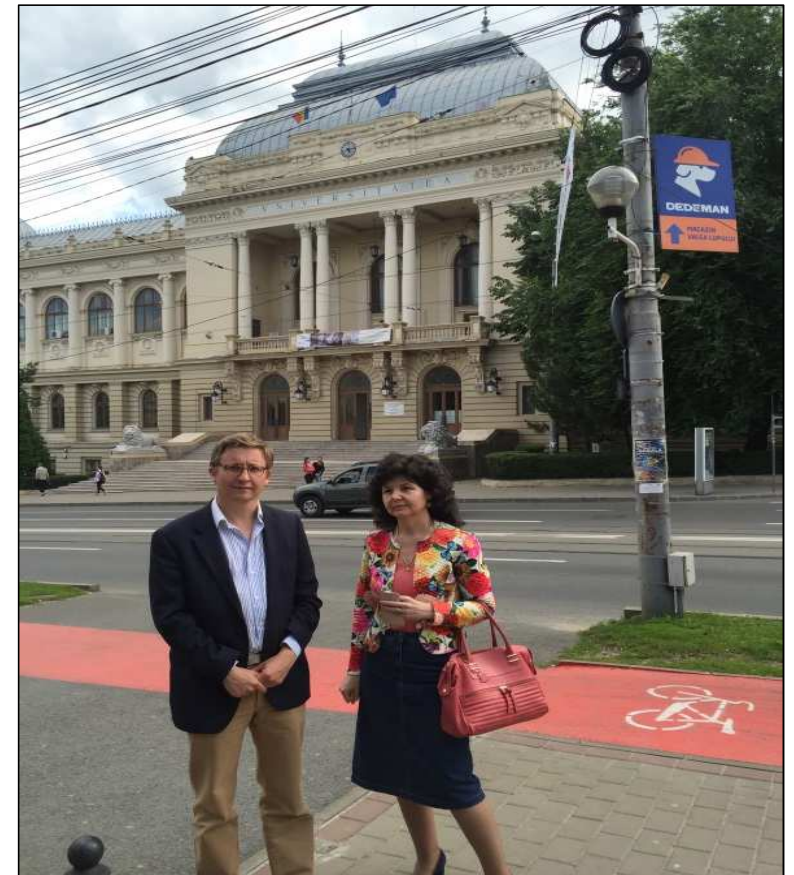
HESS Action Research

 - Methodology and work-plan for the case study
- **Background research (by end Dec 2017)**
 - Desk-research following exploratory meeting
 - Initial report on universities and S3 in Bulgaria / Severen Tsentralen
- **In depth fieldwork (January 2018 to April 2018)**
 - Interviews with universities and other stakeholders
 - Results from interviews and discussion workshop (April 2018)
- **Final report and dissemination (by end June 2018)**
 - First version in April / Final version of report as JRC publication by June 2018
 - Dissemination workshop in Brussels June 2018
