



- Start-up organizations

Perhaps partners – business?

- Individual enterprises
- State-owned enterprises
- Consultants

- Universities
- Research institutes
- Research teams
- Distinguished researchers
- Associations of researchers (e.g. PhD students, alumni etc.)

INCLUSIVE WHO ARE RELEVANT STAKEHOLDERS?

Potential partners - society

- Consumers'associations
- Organizations active in particular areas (e.g. environmental activists, organizations providing social services, organizations dealing with international cooperation etc.)

- Potential project partners
- Potential project ideas

- Influence on the public innovation agenda

Research

- Influence on the public innovation agenda
- Potential project partners
- Demand for research results
- Potential financing of research

Society

- Higher level of needs satisfaction
- Influence on the public agenda
- Influence on business

Administration

- Definition of smart specialization areas
- Better contact with business/research

MEANINGFUL POTENTIAL DISADVANTAGES OF PARTICIPATION IN EDP?

Business

- Waste of time
- Reputation loss
- Disclosure of business plans (innovation!)

Research

- Reputation loss
- Disclosure of research ideas

Society

- Waste of time
- Irrelevance for daily operations

Administration

- Messy strategic process
- Lots of effort
- Necessary to change mindset
- Vested interests / lobbying

EFFICIENT HOW TO MAKE BEST USE OF THE RESOURCES AVAILABLE?

- Plan the work
- Clear rules for operation of the working groups
- Secretariat / organization up to the administration
- Communication within and between working groups

CONTINUOUS HOW TO KEEP THE PROCESS ALIVE?

- Exemplary tasks of the working groups:
 - Definition of specialization areas
 - Definition of barriers for development, including regulatory, financial, competence etc.
 - Identification of particular areas within the WG that need to be analysed in-depth
 - Drawing-up of a roadmap for the area
 - Analysis of data regarding development of specialization
 - Advising on organization of calls

CONTINUOUS HOW TO KEEP STAKEHOLDERS ENGAGED?

Business

- Good planning, efficient organization
- Appropriate selection of partners
- Financing of projects

Research

- Opportunity to present research
- Opportunity to meet potential partners

Society

- Appropriate engagement level
- Relevant tasks

Administration

- Linkage to other tasks
- Commitment from political level

PRESTIGE

COMMUNICATION OF THE PROCESS

Political level

- Committment
- EDP in the context of public policy

Operational level

- Show results, including projects
- Communicate openness
- Appreciate work done
