Lagging Regions: Main Objectives

MAIN AIM:

Support the refinement and implementation of the RIS3 of selected EU regions

Low-growth regions:

GDP/capita below EU average



GDP/capita <50% of EU average

Generate wider lessons for all regions

Develop and provide appropriate and specific support to selected regions in RIS3 implementation



- Tailored to territorial needs
- Centred on stakeholder engagement

Develop and implement horizontal approaches to key issues in the growth and governance of RIS3



Mutual-learning workshop approach

 Foci: RIS3 Monitoring and Evaluation, Governance, Interregional Collaboration, and <u>Transitions</u>

Align with the 2021-7 enabling condition of good governance of smart specialisation strategy with 7 fulfilment criteria

- 4 Reviews of Industrial Transition following a common methodology: POINT – Projecting Opportunities for INdustrial Transitions
- Reviews of Andalusia and Greece examine energy transition.
- Reviews of Bulgaria and Romania examine digital transition
