



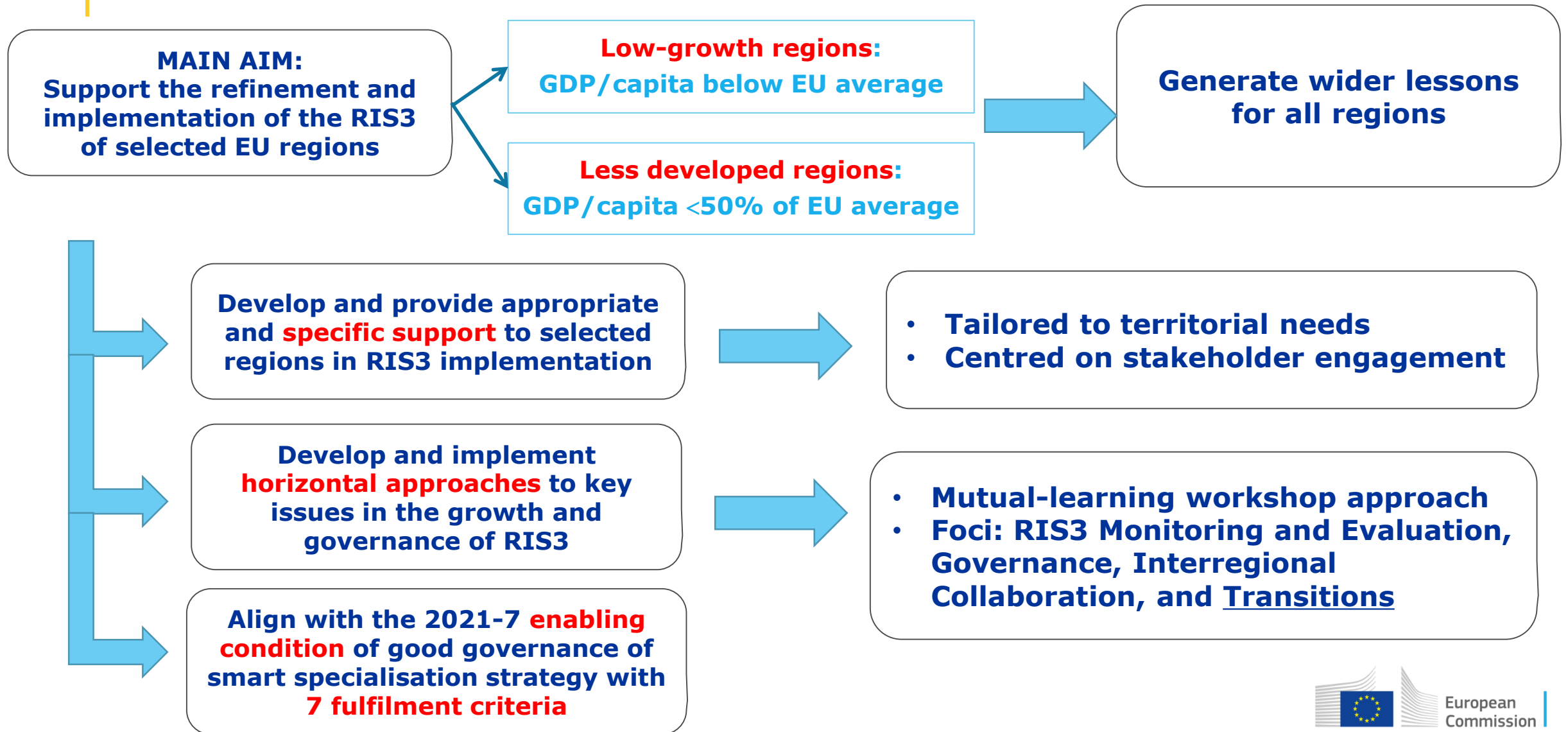

LOW GROWTH REGIONS

- **Greece** – Central Macedonia, Western Greece, Eastern Macedonia and Thrace
- **Italy** – Puglia, Campania
- **Portugal** – Algarve, Alentejo, Centro, Norte
- **Spain** – Extremadura

LESS DEVELOPED REGIONS

- **Bulgaria** – national level, Severen Tsentralen
- **Hungary** – national level, Észak-Alföld
- **Poland** – Kujawsko-Pomorskie, Lubuskie, Podlaskie, Warmińsko Mazurskie
- **Romania** – Nord-Est, Sud-Est, Sud - Muntenia, Sud-Vest Oltenia, Vest, Nord-Vest, Centru, and București - Ilfov
- **Croatia** – national level

Working Group on Industrial Transitions

- Working Group on **Understanding and Managing Industrial Transitions** - launched by JRC in 2019 to support regional/national authorities facing major industrial transitions
- 4 Reviews of Industrial Transition following a common methodology: POINT – **P**rojecting **O**pportunities for **I**ndustrial **T**ransitions
- Reviews of Andalusia and Greece examine energy transition.
- Reviews of Bulgaria and Romania examine digital transition
