Structure to reach and engage stakeholders



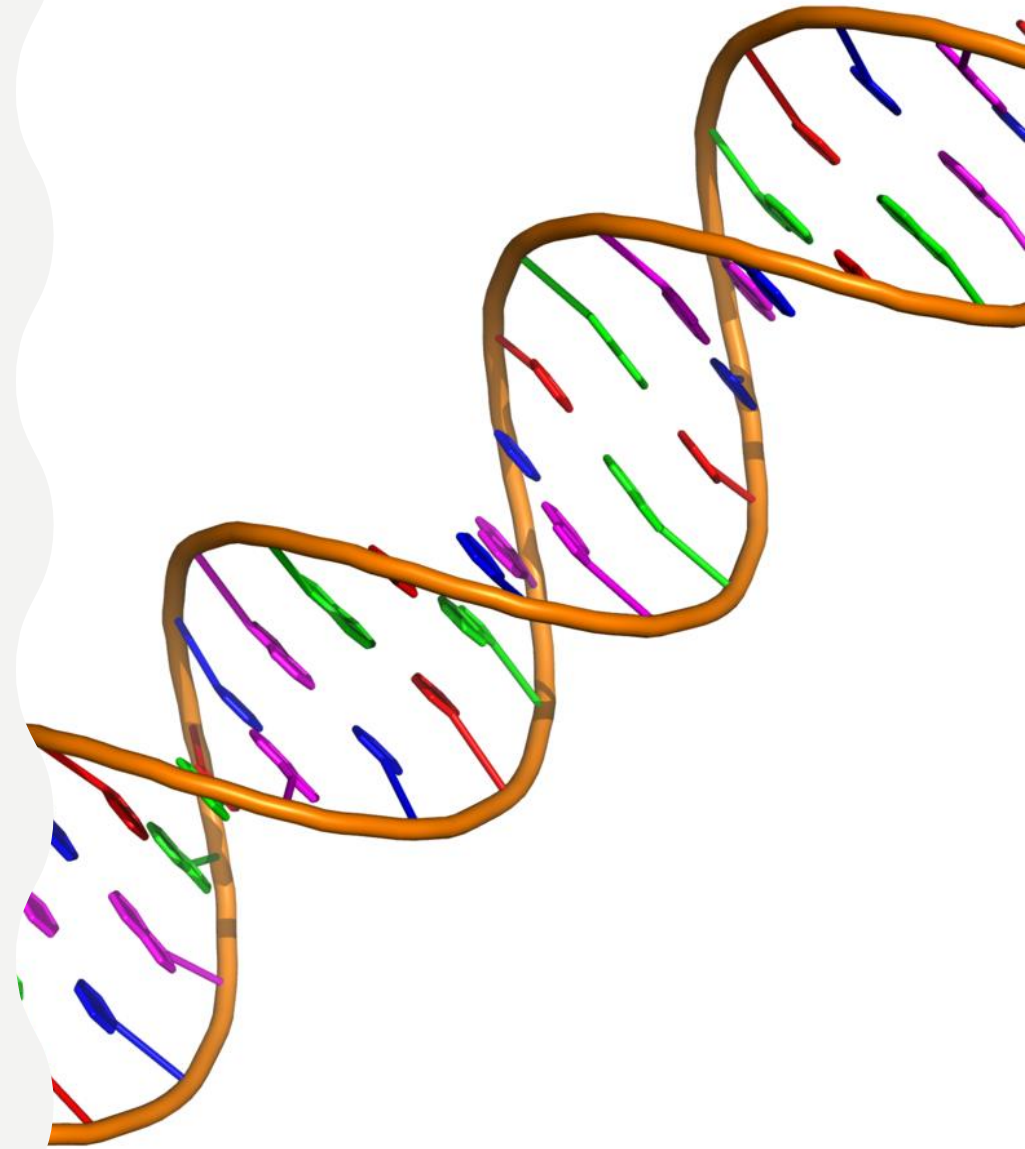
### **Instruments**

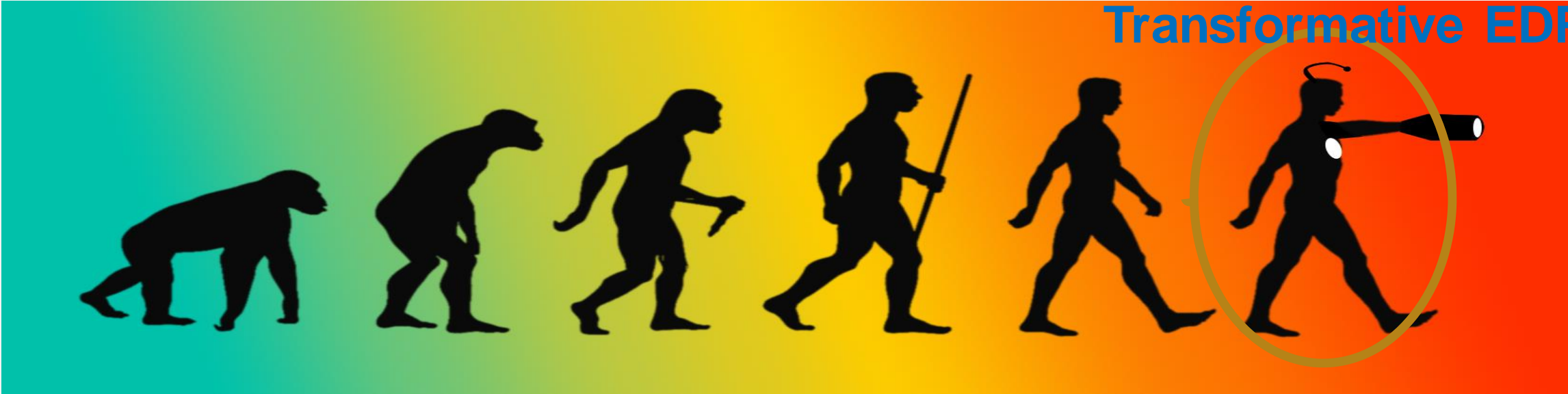
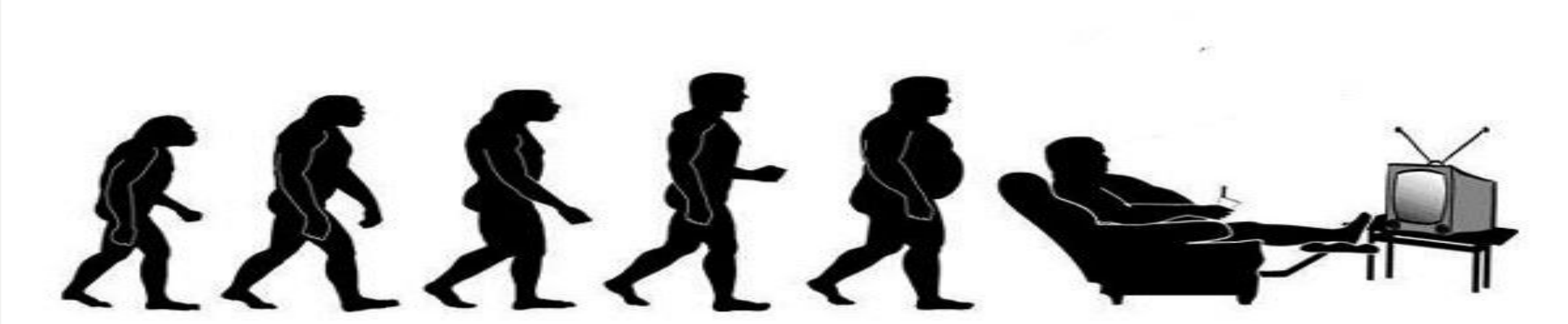
