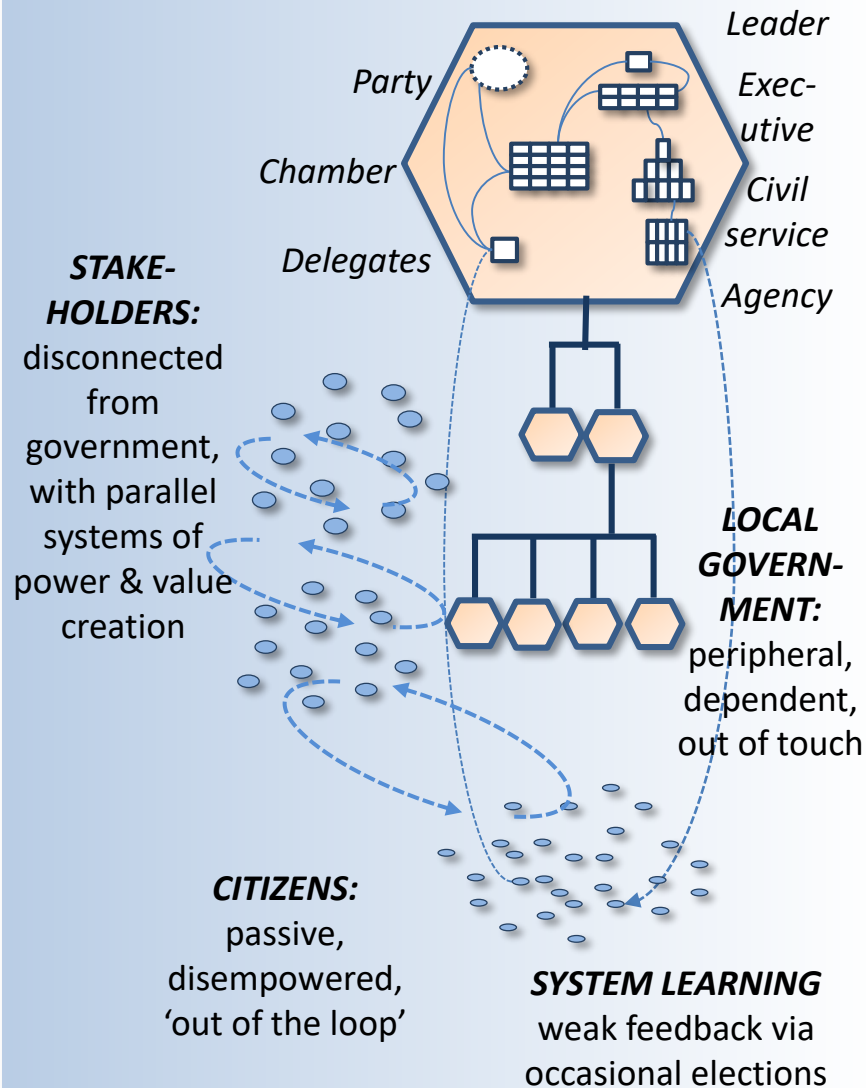

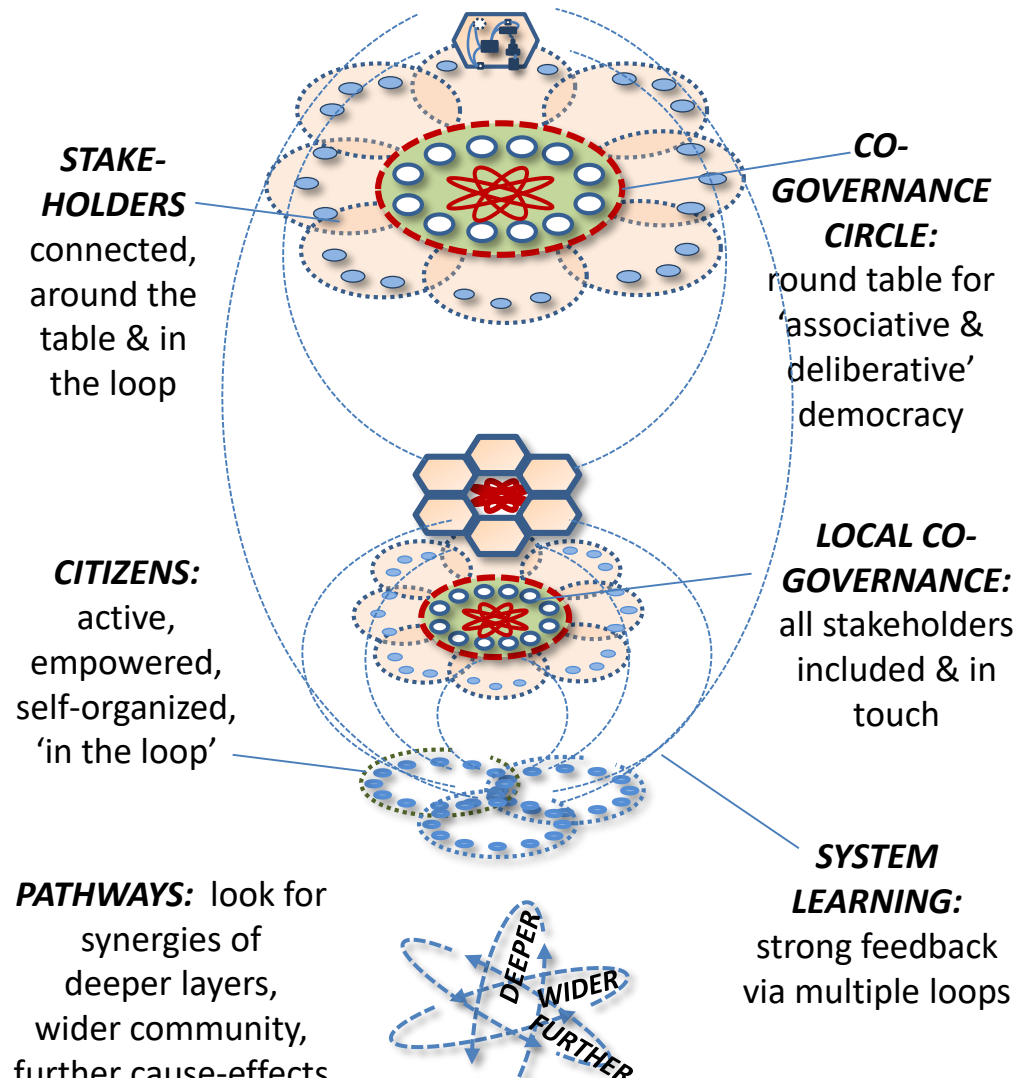
## (c) TOP-DOWN GOVERNMENT-I&II

*Syndromes of disconnected inward looking government*



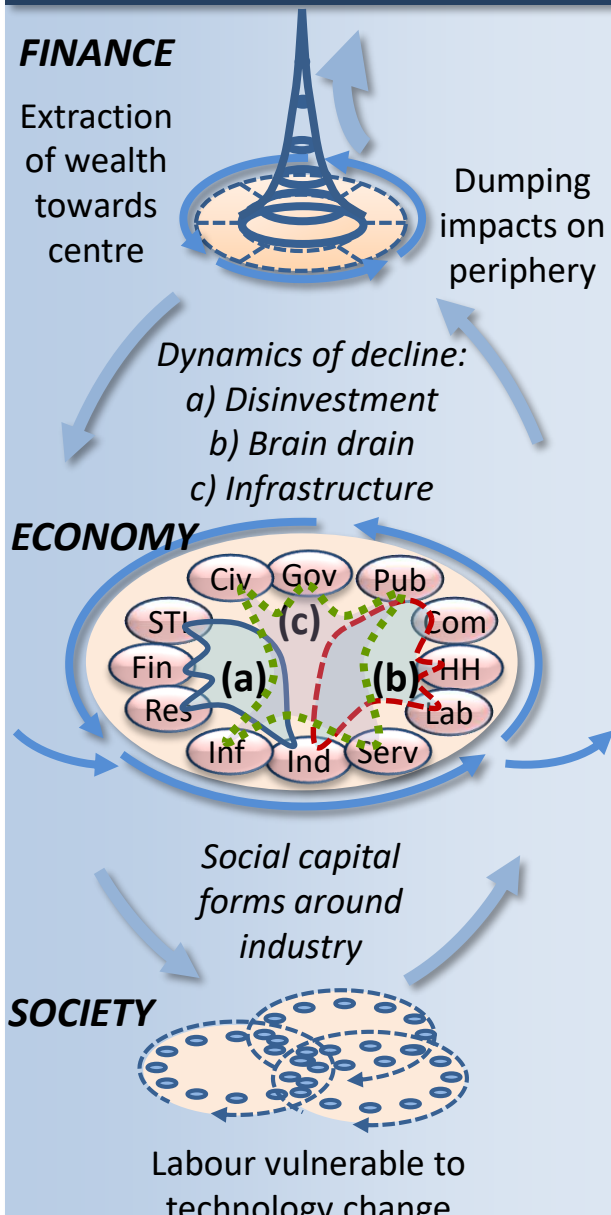
## (d) MULTI-LEVEL CO-GOVERNANCE-III

*Synergies of multi-level round tables with strong feedback*

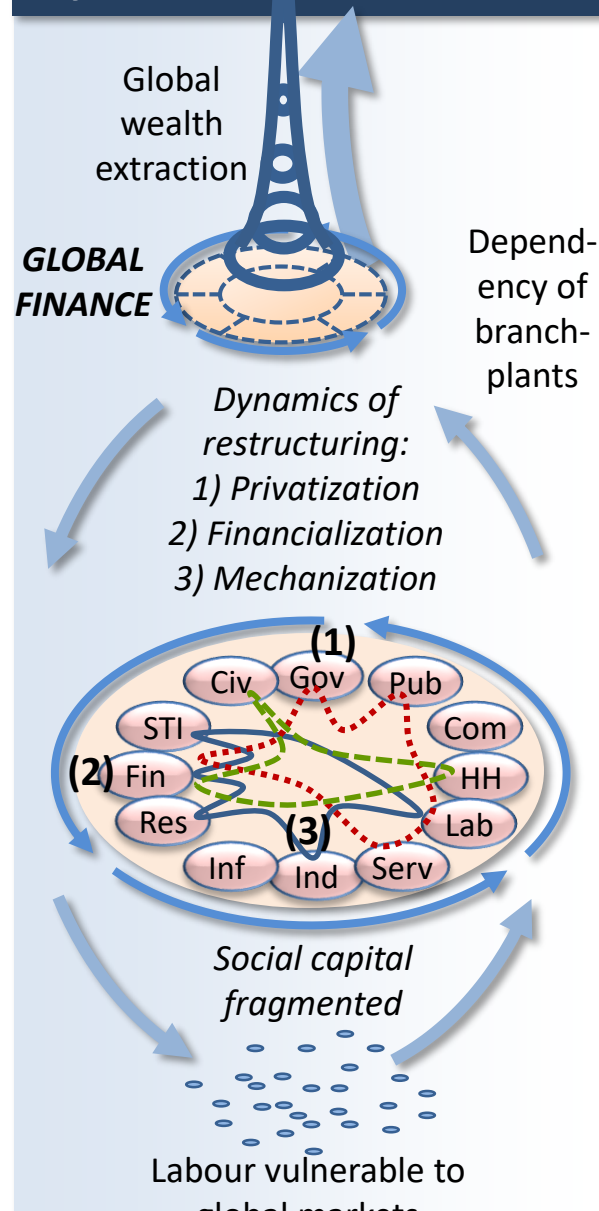

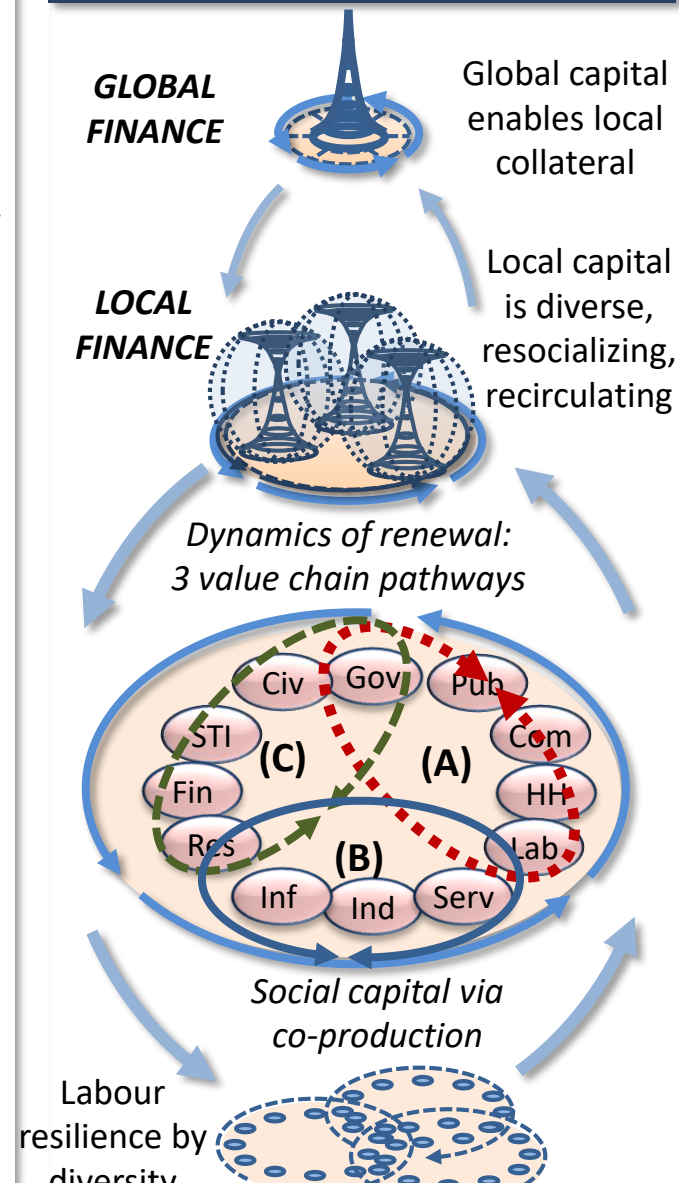
## d) LINEAR ECONOMY-I

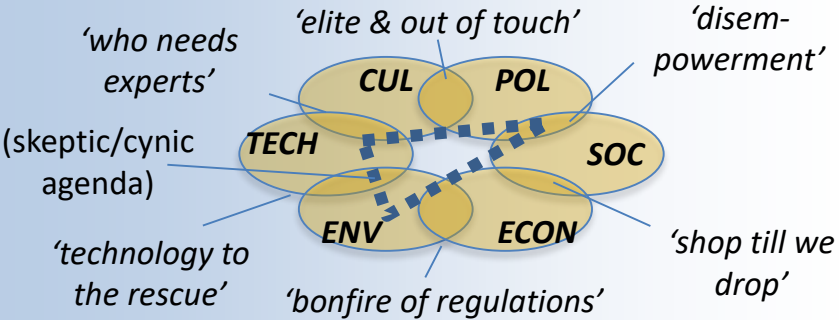

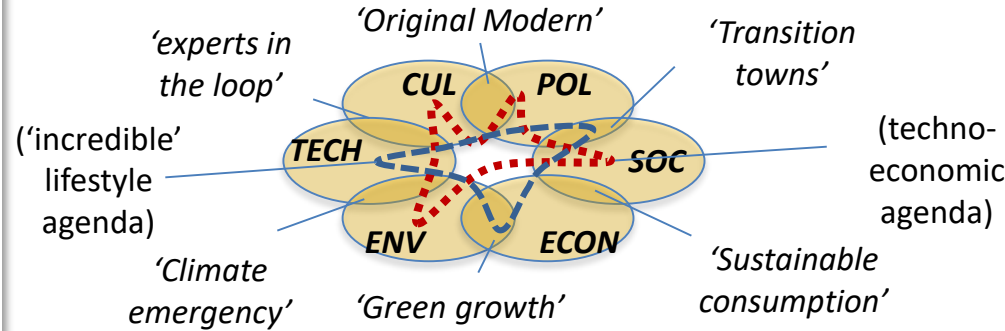
## (c) TRADING ZONES: 'NEXUS'

GM climate policy (2019): syndromes, barriers, conflicts etc.



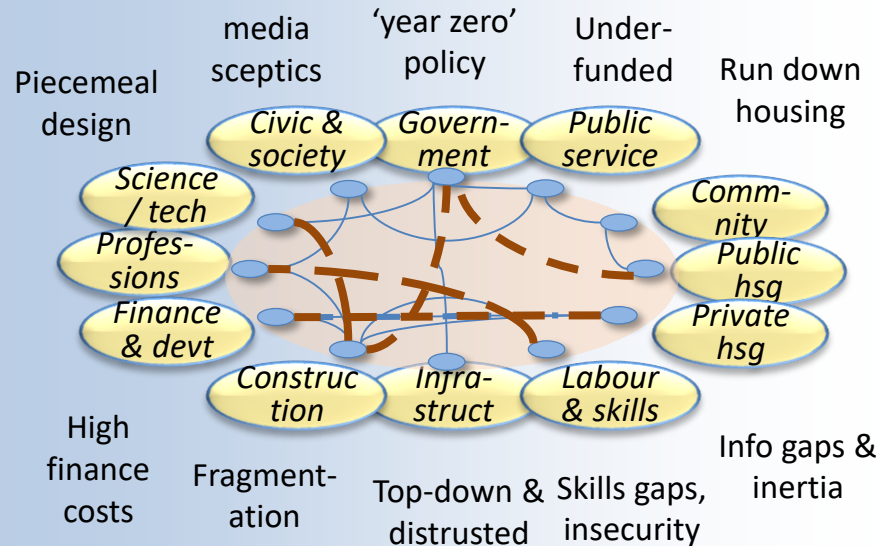
## (d) TRADING ZONES: 'CONNEXUS'

GM climate policy (2019): agendas, narratives, discourses, imaginaries



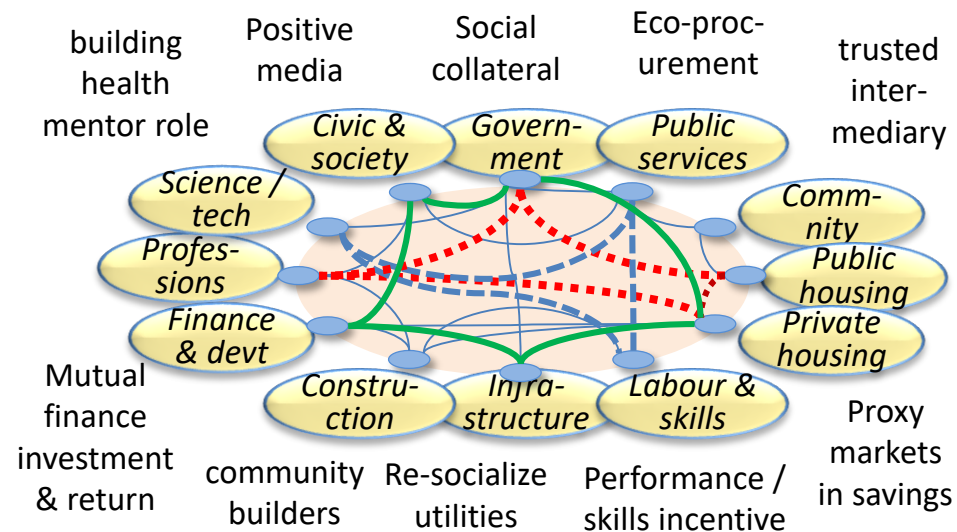
## (e) 'RETROFIT' ACTOR MAPPING : SYNDROMES
