

Three key messages

- Coordination:
 - Experimentation as source of policy change – requires persistence, risk of projectification
- Monitoring:
 - Institutional thinness delegitimizes evidence-based policy making and trust in experts – stakeholder engagement and communication is vital but very time-consuming
- Evaluation:
 - The merits of policy-learning are not self-evident in an adversarial political landscape and can easily back-fire
