- The mounting global challenges need meaningful STI solutions backed by access:
 - pandemic control
 - climate change
 - equitable social development

• Need a multi-pronged strategy towards supporting the *Global Pilot Programme on Science, Technology and Innovation for SDGs Roadmaps* initiated by the UN.

National efforts on STI for SDGs Roadmaps

- Build robust innovation ecosystem
- Data driven and technology aided foresight
- Capabilities, mapping, SDG Gap Analysis
- Financing, Partnership and Scale
- Technology adoption and transfer
- Access, Equity and Inclusion

STI for SDGs Roadmaps in India

- STI for SDGs Roadmaps in India, as decided, would focus on 4 SDGs viz. SDG 2 (Agriculture/nutrition); SDG 3 (Health and wellbeing), SDG 6 (Water and Sanitation) and SDG 7 (Affordable and Clean Energy)
- In the spirit of SDG17 (International Partnerships) India proposes to strengthen the TFM through the Global Pilot programme on STI for SDGs Roadmaps and enhance its global relevance through South-South and Triangular Cooperation with other pilot countries.
- RIS alongside the Office of the PSA has initiated the dialogue with the Cabinet Office of the Government of Japan in this regard based on mutual interest.

Expenditure Review on R&D for greater effectiveness

• Under the STI for SDGs Roadmaps initiative suggested key deliverable would be to work towards formulating a decision support system for expenditure review on R&D for greater effectiveness in the Indian context.

Scoping study in this regard has been initiated.

National Ecosystem on STI for SDGs

- RIS has initiated dialogues with relevant line ministries/departments including the
 - NITI Aayog,
 - New Emerging and Strategic Technologies Division MEA,
 - DST,
 - CSIR,
 - ICMR
 - TIFAC
- Deeper insights and leveraging the significant work undertaken by these agencies/ departments towards achieving a robust STI for SDGs Roadmaps for India.

Network of Think Tanks

- RIS has also initiated dialogue with think-tanks in India, Japan and other pilot countries; and has also started making efforts to connect with the private sector.
- A network of think-tanks from pilot and partner countries would enable convergence of perspectives from social and natural sciences; and could possibly undertake deeper engagements with all arms of the government beyond those mandated with STI portfolio to mainstream STI as a key tool of SDG implementation

- Office of PSA, RIS, CAO and UN-IATT initiative "Developing STI Partnerships for Sustainable Development: Accelerating International Cooperation and Actions through the Global Pilot Programme on STI for SDGs Roadmaps" on 29 June 2020.
- This workshop has been recognised as an official work programme of the TFM ahead of the High Level Political Forum (HLPF) in July 2020.
- Senior policymakers and experts from the pilot countries, India, Japan and UN/partner agencies, joined the workshop.
- The bilateral dialogue between India and Japan focusing on leveraging frontier technologies in implementation of the four aforementioned SDGs was hosted on 23 June 2020.
