Smart Factory HUB (Interreg Danube)

The **main objective** was to improve framework conditions for innovation in the area of **"smart factory"** ie. demonstrating the establishment of their smart specialization strategies and enhancing innovation in the context of smart manufacturing.

10 partner countries: Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Germany, Hungary, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia and Slovenia

Danube Transnational Programme

Project duration: January 2017 - June 2019

Total project value: EUR 1.8 million

- Conducted **research** for Croatia and all partner countries how active we are in Industry 4.0 and Smart Specialization (Benchmark report)
- Created handbook for 50 International Success Stories in Industry 4.0 (<u>Handbook</u>)
- Created Smart Solutions Catalog (over 100 Smart Solutions) (Cumulative report on SF solutions catalogue)
- 23 vouchers granted for feasibility study with the aim of introducing smart and innovative solutions into SME manufacturing processes (international technology transfer)
- An International Project Report for the Improvement of Industry Financing Instruments 4.0 has been produced (Policy Recommendations)

The main objective was to encourage the use of public procurement of innovative solutions (PPI) by contracting authorities throughout Central Europe, thereby also influencing the scientific and research sector to create and commercialize innovation.

6 partner countries: Hungary, Croatia, Czech Republic, Poland, Italy and Slovenia

Project duration: June 2016 - August 2019 (3 months extension)

Total project value: EUR 1.6 million

in the healthcare, ICT and energy sectors - guides with general information and examples

(SMART Health, SMART ICT, SMART Energy)

- 4 PPI2Innovate pilot projects implemented project partners from Hungary, Slovenia, Italy and Poland developed and implemented four procurement procedures for innovative solutions
- Establishment of 6 Regional Competence Centers one Competence Center in all project partner countries and 1 Central European Network of PPI2Innovate Competence Centers
- ✓ The Competence Centers aim to transfer knowledge gained through the implementation of the PPI2Innovate project and to continue monitoring and supporting the strengthening of the use of public procurement of innovative solutions (PPI).

(Interreg Mediterranean)

ODEON project addresses the **exploitation of Open Data** and aims at strengthening the relationship between digital agenda, e-government strategy, the open data platforms implemented at several levels and the availability of Open Data to support innovation process within Interreg Mediterranean Area.

8 partner countries: Italy (2partners), Montenegro, Croatia, Slovenia, Grece, Spain and France

Project duration: February 2018 – July 2020

Total project value: EUR 2 million

CEUP 2030 - Central Europe Upstreaming for Policy Excellence in Advanced Manufacturing & Industry 4.0 towards 2030 (Interreg Central Europe)

Project strives for **policy excellence in Industry 4.0/Advanced Manufacturing.** Focuses on improving policy-making by utilizing, adapting and upgrading existing and policy-making outputs. The upgrade process deals mainly with RIS3 policies.

The 4 main topics covered in the project are to create a comprehensive thematic framework and present a realistic picture of Industry 4.0: • large and real data processing and sensors, • automation and robotics, • new materials and • Artificial Intelligence.

The project sets out a unique approach to an innovation system for creating regional and transnational policies with high practical relevance.

10 partner countries: Poland, Germany (2 partners), Austria (2 partners), Italy (2 partners), Slovenia, Croatia and Hungary

Project duration: March 2020 – February 2022

Total project value: EUR 1 million
