

Main achievements


- Establishments and investments are increasing
 - Northvolt, Komatsu, SCA, SMÅA, Högalid
- Three universities producing world leading research
 - UPSC, MIMS, Umeå Institute of Design
- New clusters and development of existing
 - Cleantech, Forest Technology, Georange
- New sustainable infrastructure
 - Best broadband in EU, North Bothnia line, Kvarken Link

- Strong innovation actors
 - Umeå Biotech Incubator,
 Arctic Business Incubator
- Innovative public sector
 - Center for Rural medicine, Innovations clinics



Challenges

- Large intra-regional differences
 - Innovation support and environments are found along the coast.
- Equality
 - Mostly men with a Swedish background use and manage the innovation systems.
- Access to capital
 - For SME:s
- Regional innovation management
 - We lack a proactive "gardener".





Plans


- A new regional innovation strategy for smart specialisation (RIS3).
