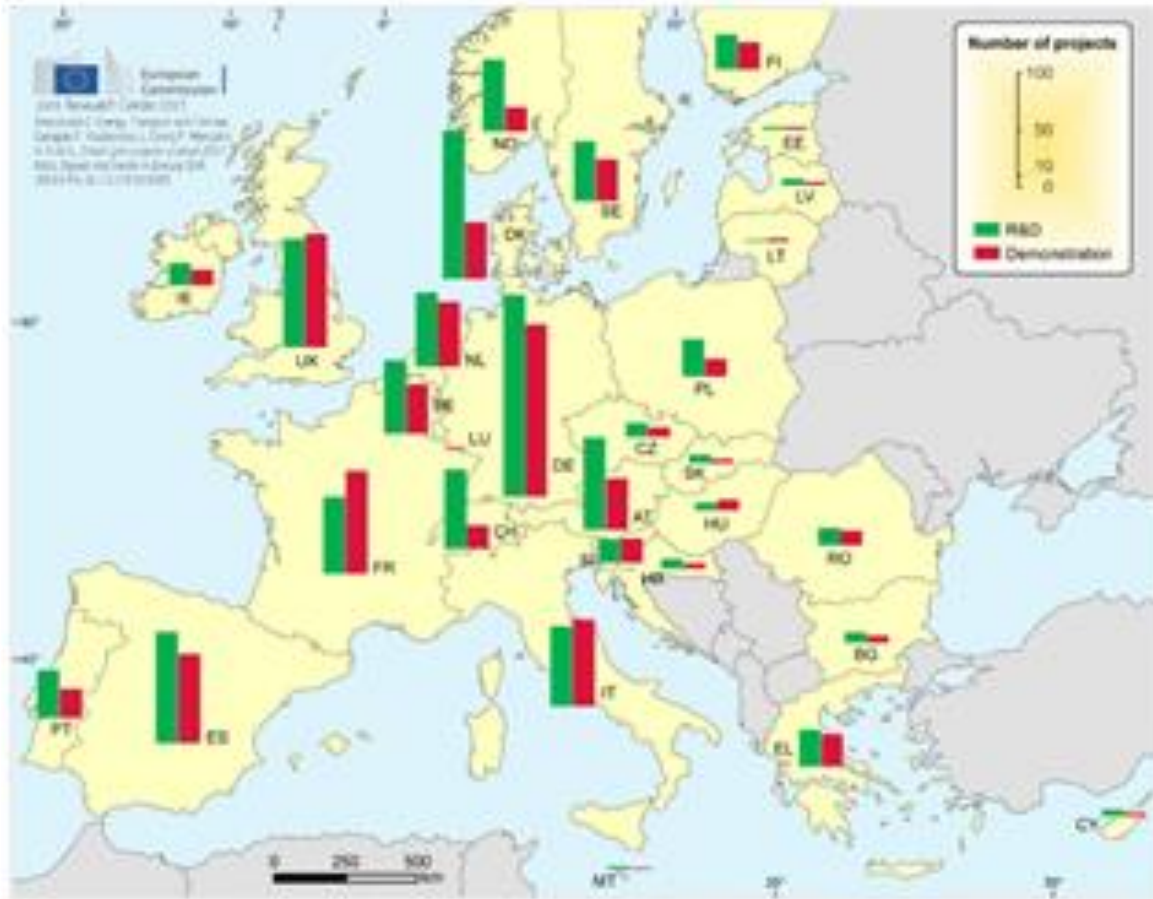

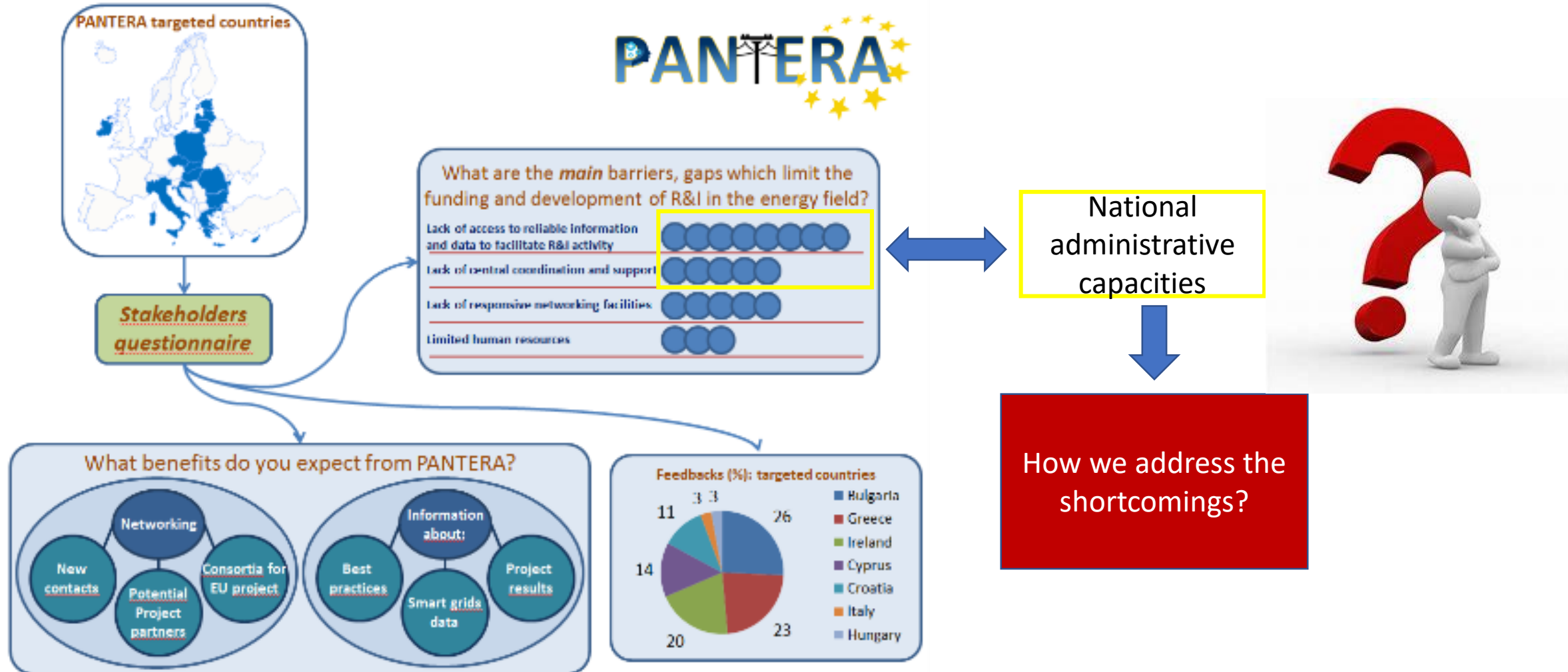


# The fact for R&I projects within EU

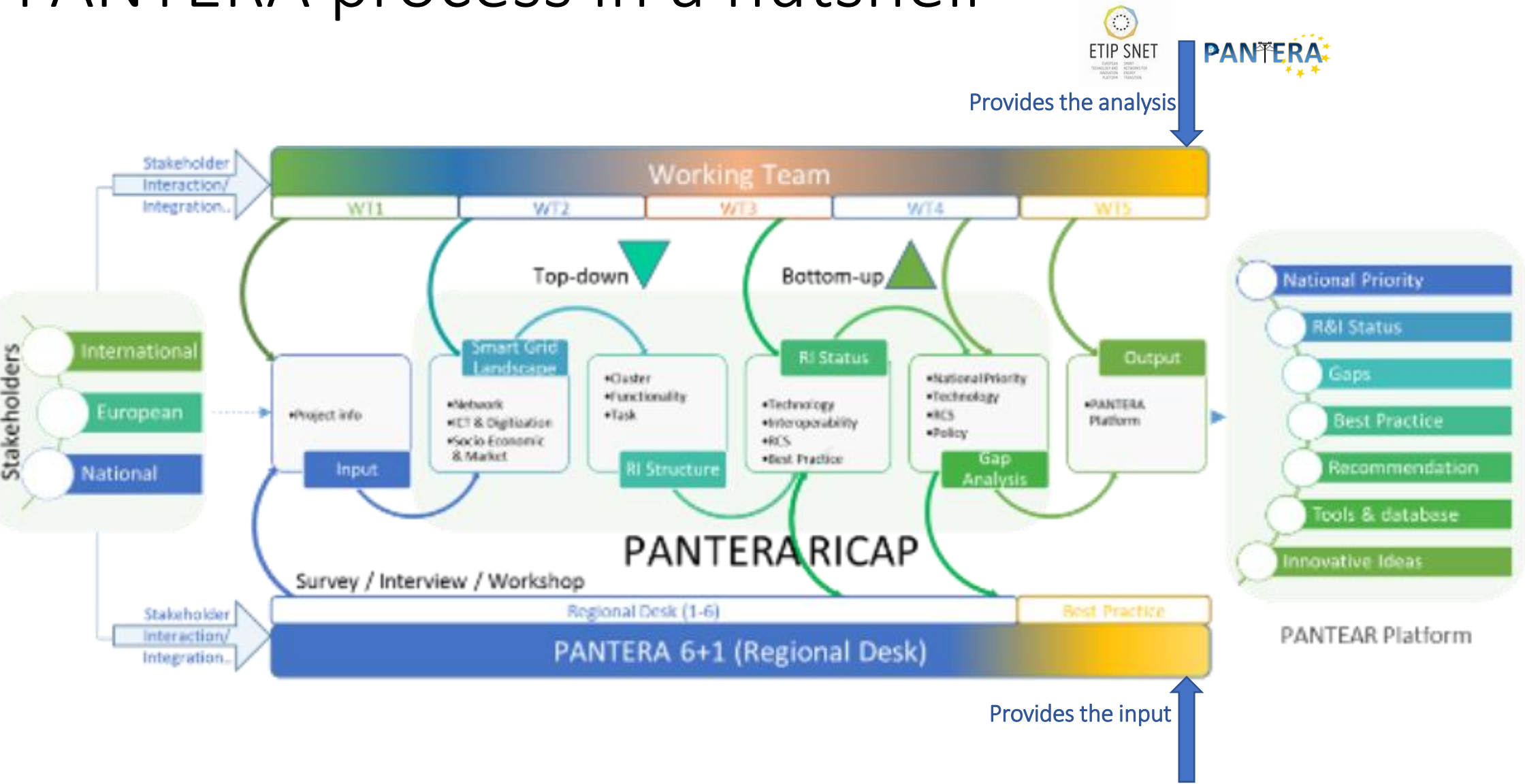

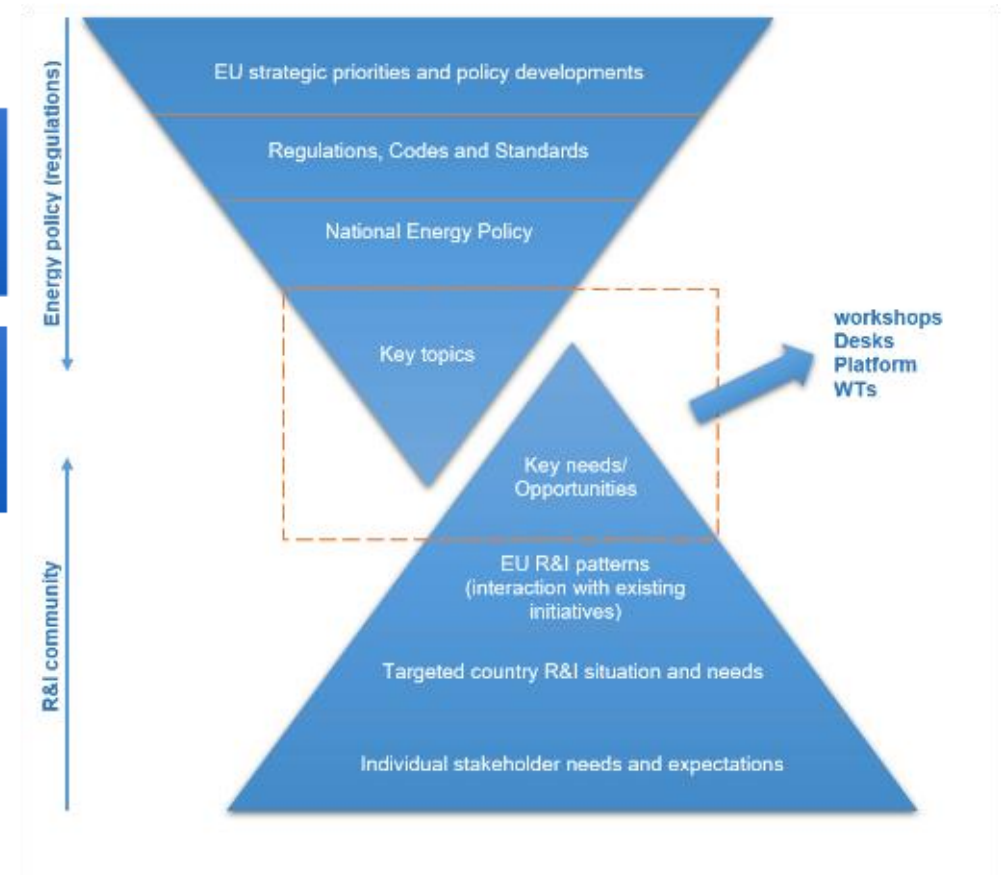
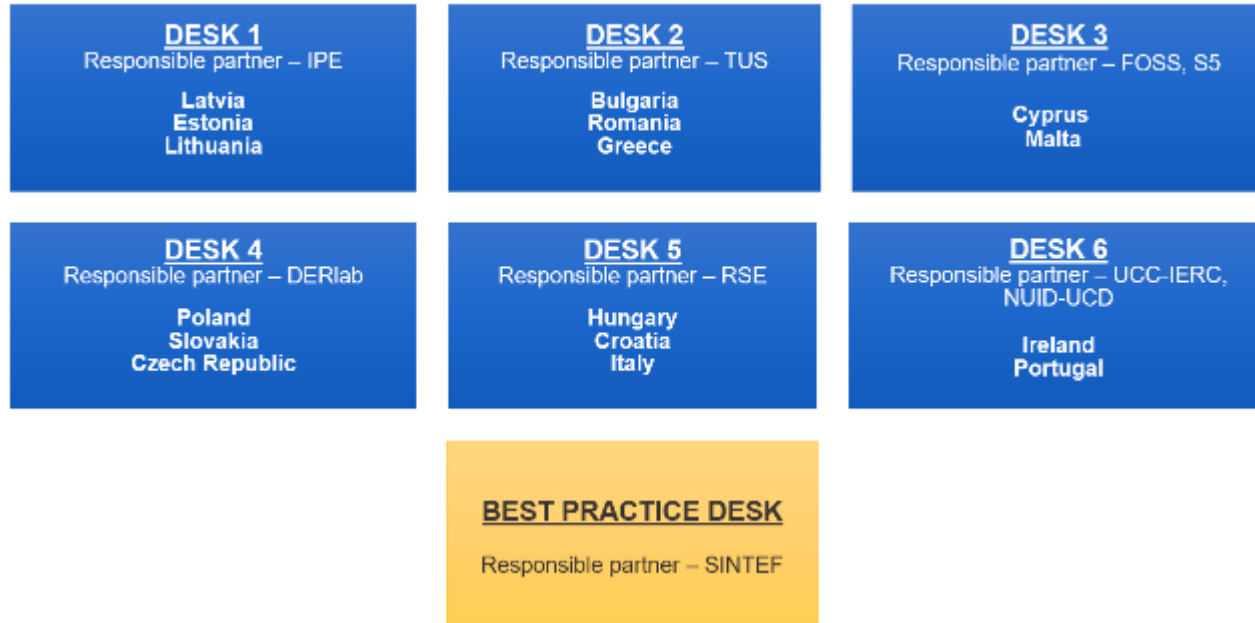


# PANTERA process in a nutshell

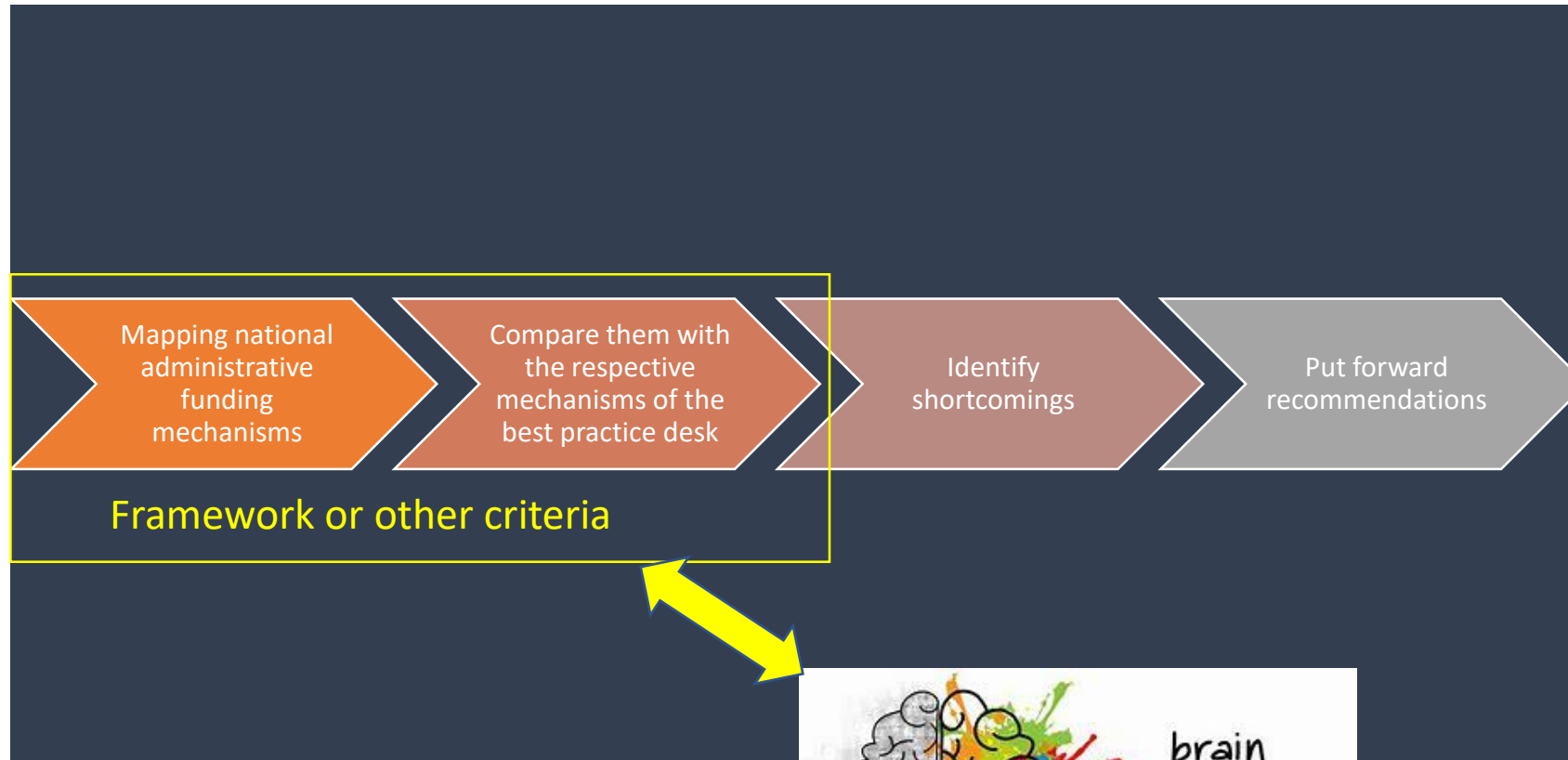


# Zoom in PANTERA Regional Approach
