



# Catalysing the EDP in Lagging Regions

#### EDP focus group approach


- Lagging Regions methodology to engage Quadruple Helix stakeholders to develop priorities and identify ideas for innovative projects
- First developed in Eastern Macedonia & Thrace (EL) (wine, tourism, marble, meat and dairy etc.)
- Rolled out and refined across LR partner regions and beyond
- Applied at sub-regional level (e.g. mechatronics, Gabrovo, BG)

### Project Development Labs (PDL)

 Aim to further develop focus group project ideas – focus on funding dimension (link to S2E)

# Cosmetics and food supplements based on natural resources



#### 38 project ideas:

- Database of plant resources edible plants for anti/healthy-ageing
- Anti-acne products
- Transylvanian Cosmatopea Cluster
- Locally branded bio products
- In-house technology quality control and testing of ingredients and final products
- Smart packaging: anti-microbe protection and smart labels changing colour if expired
- Cosmetics and (para)pharma: From harmful to beneficial cosmetics



# Horizontal support, peer learning & analysis

- Issues common to the partner regions and relevance to five policy objectives (especially PO1), associated enabling conditions and fulfilment criteria:
  - Governance, Monitoring and Evaluation (2,3,4,5)
  - Managing Industrial Transitions (6)
  - Transregional and transnational collaboration (7)
  - Crosscutting concerns administrative capacity building and cooperation



# RIS3 Governance: national and regional

- Greece shifting focus from regional to national and articulation between them
  - Diffusing impact on REMTh and collaboration with national RIS3 network of regions
- Romania success in 2 RO pilot regions led to full roll-out
  - Centralised strategy but JRC & REGIO working to develop governance, ecosystem, EDP and capacities to manage funding
- Bulgaria challenge of centralised approach
  - Development of ecosystem (innovation hubs) and need to harness sub-regional potential
- Spain and Italy lessons for national/regional coordination (e.g. monitoring)
  - LR project led to successful Interreg bids by ES and IT partners



# Monitoring & Evaluation – system & impacts


- JRC MOOC initially developed with Lagging Regions
- Monitoring S3 priority areas
- Combining functions: measuring & accountability also communication & learning
- No simple recipe: good monitoring system requires significant knowledge of the territory and its strategy in all its complexity
- Coordination of national and regional RIS3 monitoring
  - cross-regional stakeholder working groups
- Integration of evaluation of RIS3 efficient, appropriate, effective –
