- Located in the north-west of the Iberian Peninsula, near the Atlantic.
- 12 NUTS III, 4 in Galicia and 8 in Portugal:
  - Galicia: A Coruña, Lugo, Ourense and Pontevedra.
  - Norte: Alto Minho, Ave, Cávado, Área Metropolitana do Porto, Alto Tâmega, Tâmega e Sousa, Douro, and Terras de Trás – os – Montes.





# 2. RIS3T Vision and Strategic Collaboration

### **Shared Vision**

Converging with the most developed regions of the European Union based on the commitment to R & D & I

### **Objective**

Establish a collaborative framework based on Smart specialisation to provide a coordinated response to common challenges, mobilize new initiatives and projects and initiate joint R & D & i funding pathways





### 2. RIS3T Vision and Strategic Collaboration

- Smart specialisation as a strategic aim to boost economic development through more efficient and effective support for R&I, taking into account regions' specific characteristics and assets.
- Interregional collaboration as a central issue: competitiveness based on the increasing density of international relations, both in terms of knowledge generation and of economic integration at global level.
- A coordinated approach, contributing to:
  - Higher critical mass levels based on synergies and complementarities of innovation at the global value chain level;
  - Better use of different sources of funding and reinforcement of their complementarity (mainly at Regional Operational Programmes;
  - Raise funds based on the competitive excellence of the Euroregion (e.g. H2020).





# 3. RIS3T Methodological Approach


Developing stages of RIS3T		
1. Analysis	Based on <b>individual in-depth diagnosis</b> of the regions of Galicia and Norte de Portugal, <b>joint documents</b> (PIC and POCTEP 2014-2020) and <b>contributions</b> from regional teams and key players.	
2. Governance	Setting up a governance model for the definition of the joint strategy, based on the structures already presented in regional RIS3, that will include the following bodies: Steering Committee, Technical Team, Working Groups and RIS3T Forums.	
3. Vision	Build a <b>global vision</b> for the future ot the Euroregion based on the joint analysis carried out in stage 1.	
4. Selection of Strategic Areas of Collaboration	Select <b>common areas</b> within the framework of individual RIS3 strategies (and deepening of common topics) in order to identify priority actions.	
5. Common Actions and Support Measures	Setting out <b>common measures</b> that can be carried out jointly by both regions to achieve the vision, using <b>different kinds of funding available at European level</b> (Territorial Cooperation Programs, Horizon 2020, Cosme, Life, etc.)	
6. Monitoring and Evaluation	Definition of common indicators for <b>monitoring and evaluation</b> of the Strategy



Participation in international networks	Participation in international networks of Smart specialisation Strategies, notably in the <b>S3 Platform</b> promoted by the EC and the <b>Vanguard Initiative - New growth through smart specialisation</b> involving 30 European regions
INTERREG EUROPE 2014-2020	<b>Participation in the interregional cooperation project MONITORIS3.</b> This project seeks to exchange experiences at the level of monitoring mechanisms and policy development methodologies in the implementation of RIS3.
INTERREG V A Spain - Portugal	Participation in the cross-border cooperation project IMPACT RIS3T. This project aims to implement cooperation actions at the cross - border RIS3 level Galicia - Norte de Portugal (RIS3T).

Operationalization of the RIS3T Governance Model	Setting up the Steering Committee and the Management Team; establishment of working groups; development of collaborative tools.	
Implementation of the RIS3T Monitoring System	Establishment of the R & D & I observatory at the Euroregion level for the monitoring of RIS3T.	
RIS3T Promotion	RIS3T dissemination initiatives; institutional capacity building of stakeholders; R & D & I support services at Euroregion level.	





### **Concluding remarks | Major challenges**

- New process: requiring new ways of articulation between regions and stakeholders - need of maturation and of an increasing density of relations;
- **Institutional difficulties:** institutional instability, lack of critical masses of skills/resources;.
- Impact: need to strengthen results, linking INTERREG programmes with Regional ones capitalization.



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
