

All programmes, all countries:


Slovenia:

- 477 mio EUR approved ERDF (58 %)
- 289 approved projects

- Slovenian partners in 189 projects
- Slovenian partners in 65% of all projects
- 299 Slovenian partners
- 30 coordinators from Slovenia
- Total contractual value for Slovenian partners: 60 mio EUR (actual financing 51 mio EUR from ERDF + 5 mio EUR Interreg)
