The Working Committee meetings allow lead and partner regions to:

- assess and benchmark the progress of each partnership, discuss any ongoing/future challenges and develop new solutions;
- receive information on possible synergies with other initiatives, e.g. Interreg, EIT Food or EIB;
- share strategic guidance for the next period on key issues such as building synergies with EU funding programmes, overcoming regulatory obstacles for investment, understanding financial instruments, and skills.

Furthermore, S3P Agri-food Working Committee meetings offer thematic partnerships to organise their technical meetings.

The Smart Specialisation Platform for Agri-Food (S3P Agri-Food) was established in June 2016 at EU level with an aim to accelerate the development of joint investment projects in the EU by encouraging and supporting interregional cooperation in thematic areas based on smart specialisation priorities defined by regional and national government linked to agriculture and food. The S3P Agri-Food is there to help EU regions and member states implement their smart specialisation strategies more efficiently, while providing regional stakeholders new cooperation opportunities with partners from across the European Union. As of June 2018, the S3P Agri-Food platform supports five interregional partnerships involving stakeholders from 49 regions from 18 countries. The partnerships are focusing on strategic themes ranging from Smart Sensors, Traceability & Big Data to Consumer Involvement in Agri-Food, from Nutritional Ingredients to High Tech Farming. Today's session is an opportunity to learn and have a dialogue with these captivating partnerships are working together across Europe to develop a pipeline of investment projects connected to very specific thematic areas of smart specialisation.
