
A stream of cooperation

## **Objective of the Danube Transnational Programme**

DTP 2014-2020 finances projects implemented by transnational consortia aiming at improving the public policies and institutional cooperation in the Danube region.

- Policy character at macroregional level – acting as a link between national and EU level

- A Programme aiming at mere networking!






## **Innovative and socially responsible Danube Region**

- 2.3: Foster the restoration and management of ecological corridors
- 2.4: Improve preparedness for environmental risk management



## **Better connected and energy responsible Danube Region**

- 3.1: Support environmentally-friendly and safe transport systems and balanced accessibility of urban and rural areas
- 3.2: Improve energy security and energy efficiency



## **Well governed Danube Region**

- 4.1: Improve institutional capacities to tackle major societal challenges
- 4.2: Support the governance and implementation of the EUSDR

## **DTP supports joint cooperation projects which:**

- Develop institutional capacity and ensure knowledge transfer
- Pave the way to new investments
- Support the development of a common framework for policy implementation in various fields

## **DTP supports joint cooperation projects which:**

- Support policy harmonisation in various fields
- Develop innovative solutions to common problems

- **54 projects approved** with starting date of Dec 2016/Jan 2017
- **PA1 projects focusing on Smart Specialization:**
  - **Accelerator** – smart growth for accelerators programmes
  - **Crowdstream** – smart financing for SMEs
  - **DanuBioValNet** – alignment of S3 and cluster policies in bio-economy
  - **D-STIR** – improving framework conditions for S3 implementation
  - **InnoHPC** – ICT support for regional industrial S3
  - **Made in Danube** - implementation of smart specialization strategies to local industry (focus also on MD&UA) – agro-food, wood industry, biofuel
  - **Moveco** – circular economy and smart growth
  - **ResInfra@DR** – analyzing the compatibility between RI and S3

- CP under approval at European Commission level



# Which SOs can be addressed?

<b>S.O</b>	<b>Restriction for the 2<sup>o</sup>d Call for Proposal</b>
<b>S.O 1.1</b>	<b>Open: <u>restricted</u></b> to commercialisation of research results and technology transfer: cluster policies and transnational cluster cooperation based on <b>smart specialisation</b> approaches; management of intellectual property rights for supporting innovation
<b>S.O 2.1</b>	<b>Open: <u>restricted</u></b> to flood prevention (monitoring / early warning systems; preventive solutions) and/or water quality management (e.g. harmonised monitoring and assessment systems and solutions, measures to reduce nutrient and hazardous substance pollution, more efficient waste water treatment solutions)
<b>S.O. 3.1</b>	<b>Open: <u>restricted</u></b> to multi/ inter-modality (especially inclusive but not limited to rail and air transport), transport safety (inclusive of ITS, if applicable), IWT fleet modernisation, connectivity of rural areas and improvement of public transport
<b>S.O.</b>	1.2, 2.2, 2.3, 2.4, 3.2 – <b>please see Cooperation Programme</b> <b>Open - <u>unrestricted</u></b>
<b>S0 4.1</b>	<b>Closed for the second call</b>
