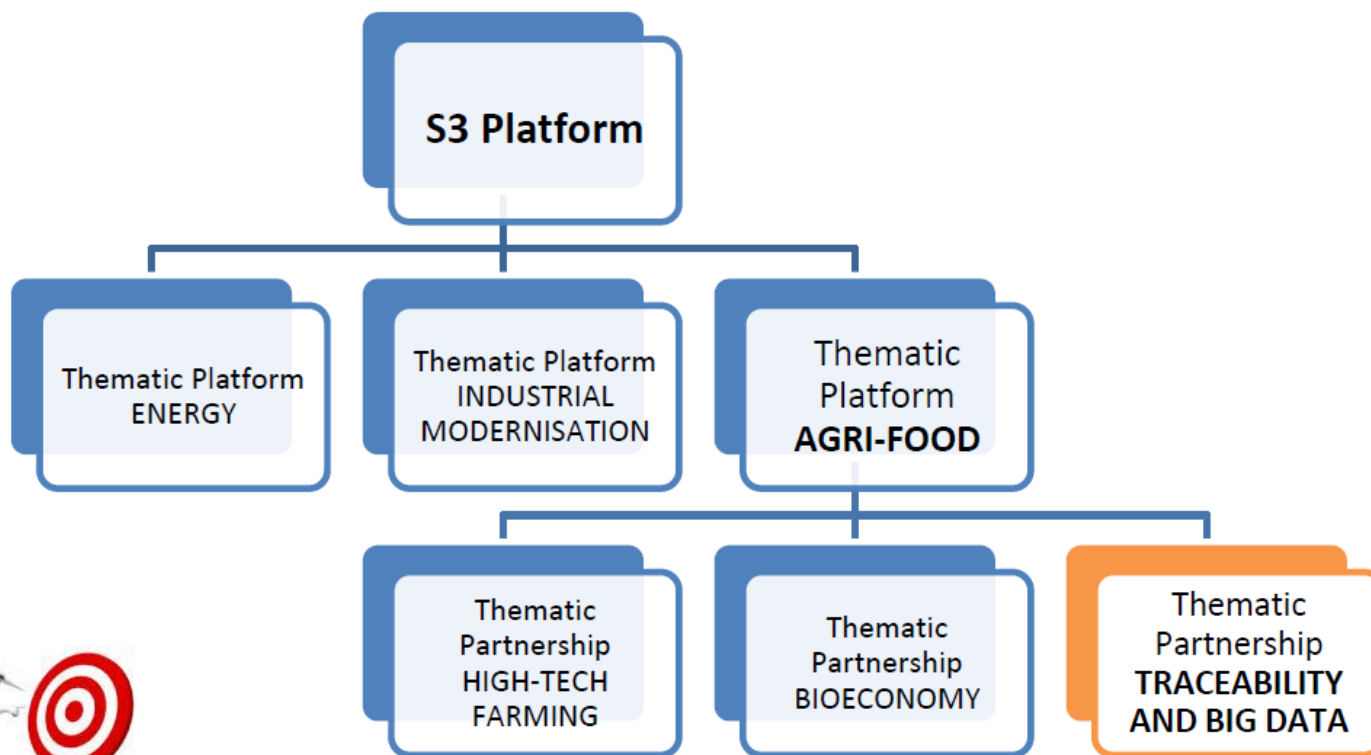

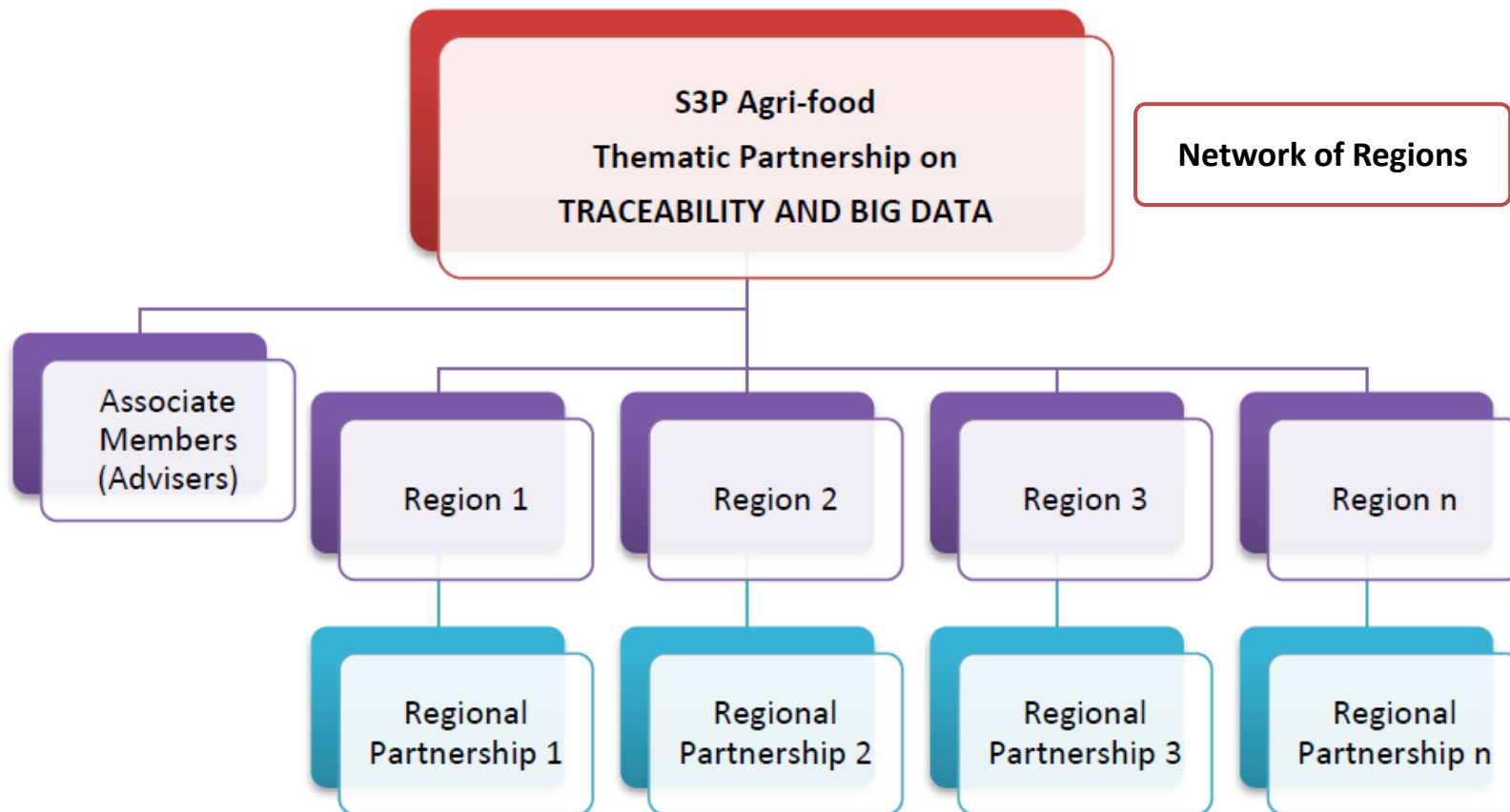
The Governance and Management Framework regulates decision making and operation of the Interregional Partnership on “Traceability & Big Data”, as well as the roles and responsibilities of partners.

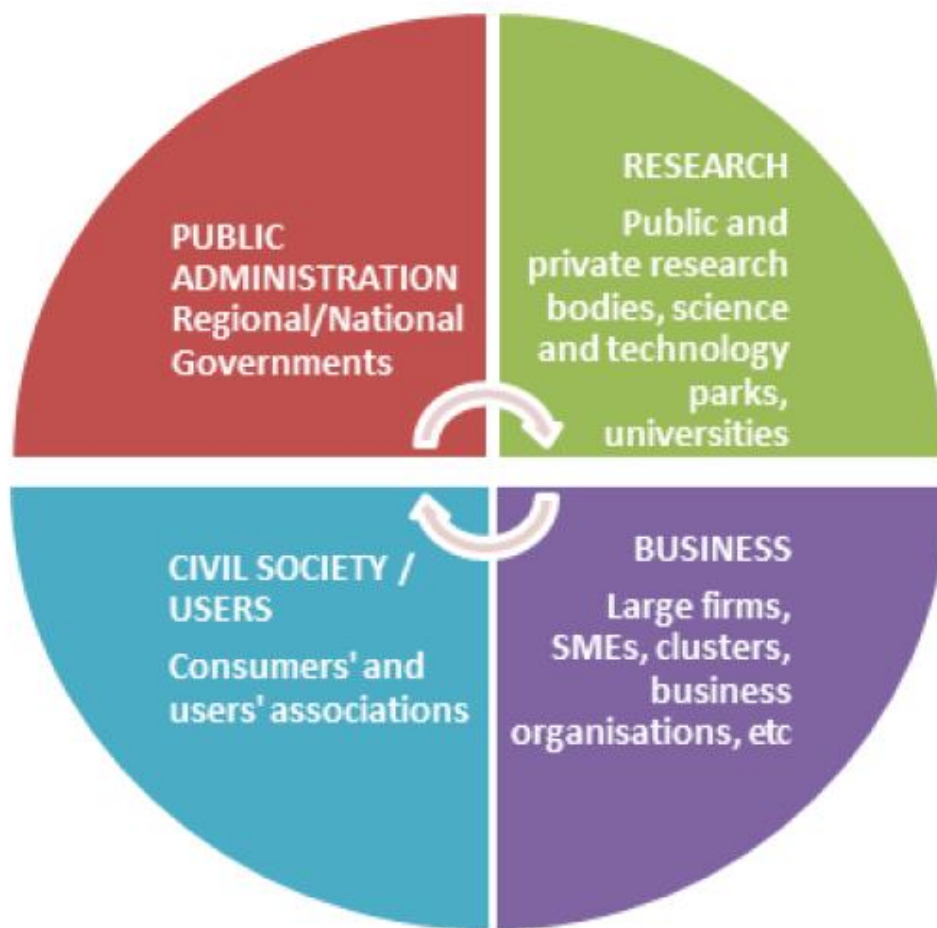


The Thematic Partnership on “Traceability & Big Data” will encourage the creation of an ecosystem to support innovation and digitisation of the agri-food sector in Europe.

## The Interregional Thematic Partnership



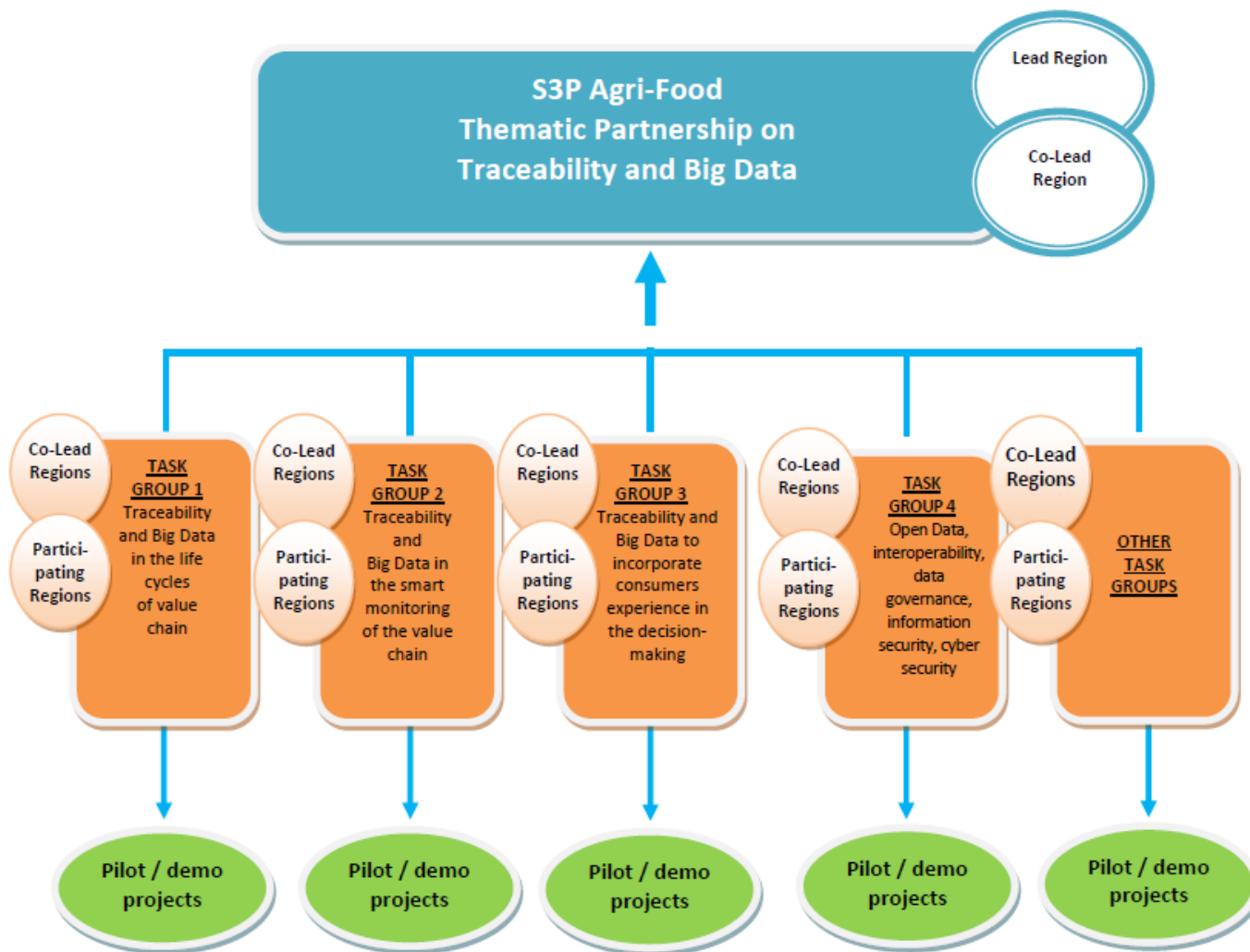
## Regional Partnerships



Common foundations for a data-driven agri-food include:

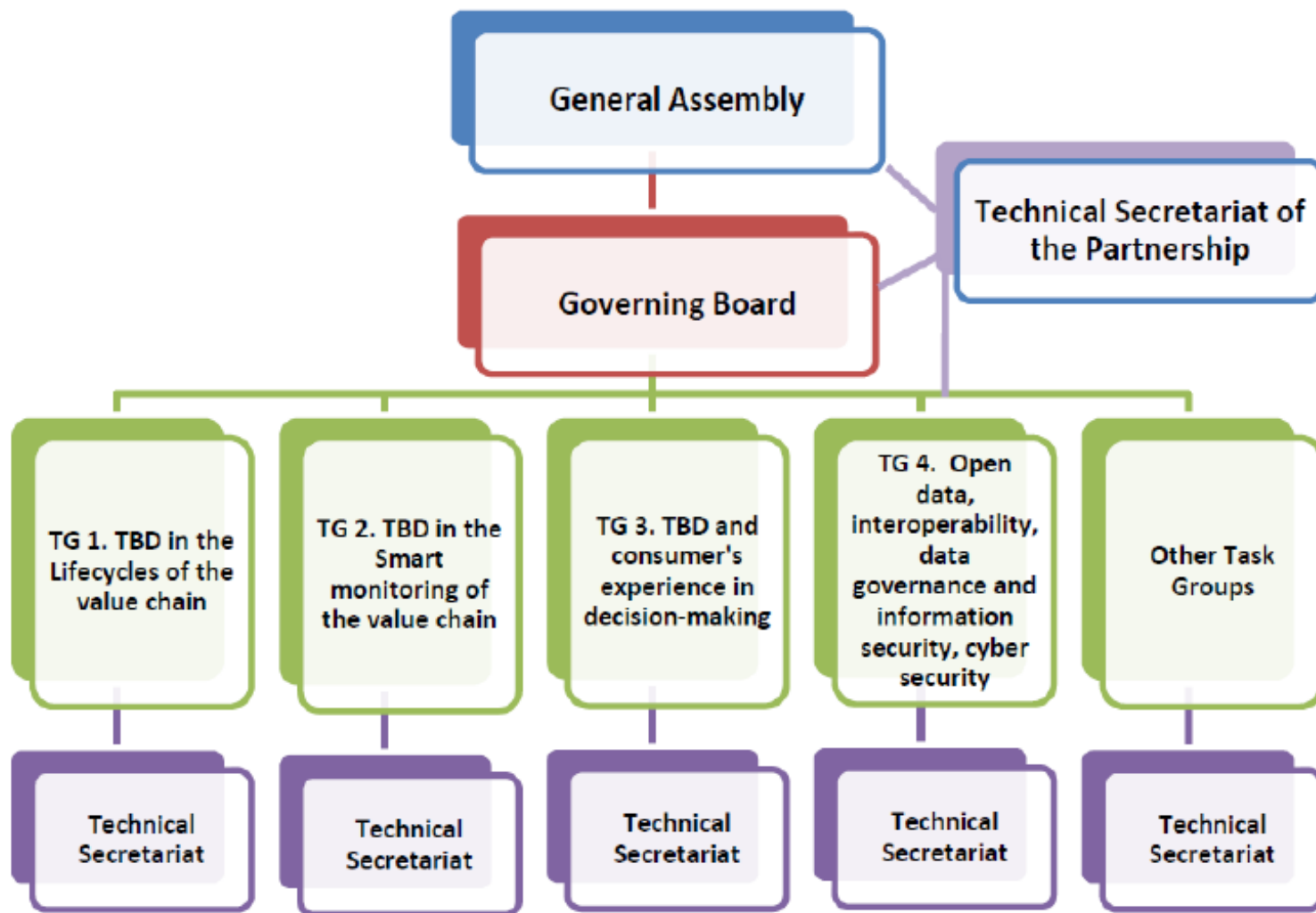
- More complete and trusted **information available** to consumers.

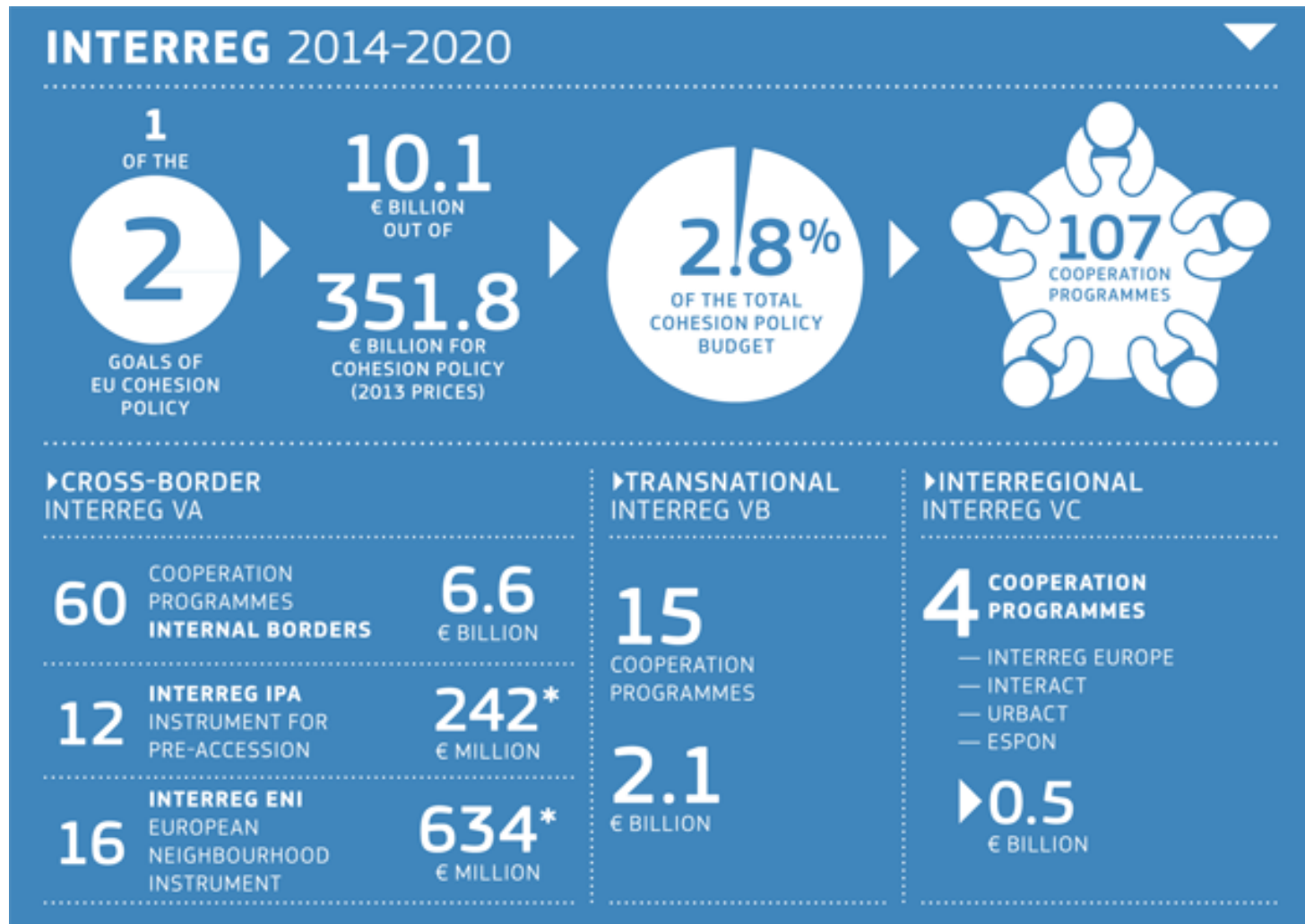

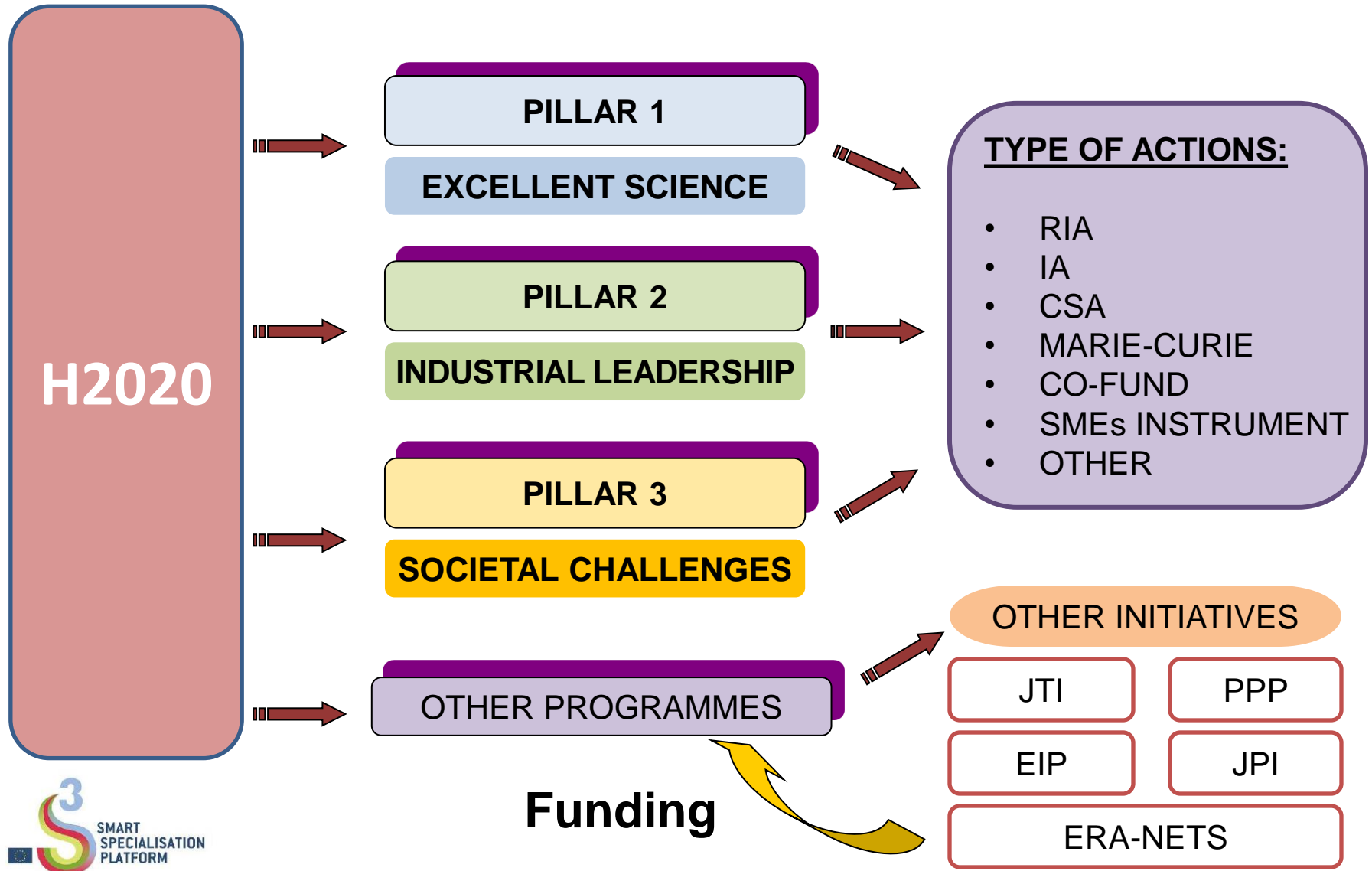

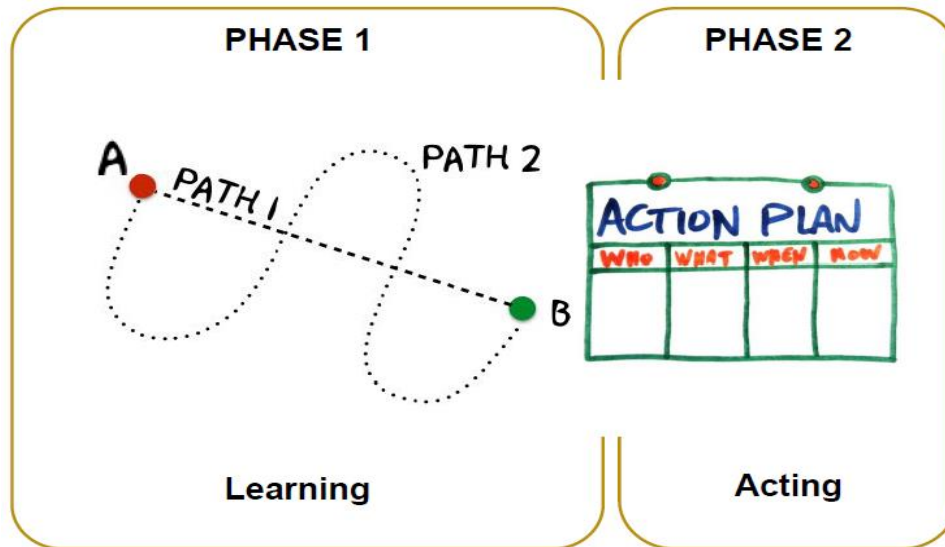
# Interreg Europe project proposal

Co-finance: 85% (public authorities) – 75 % (non-profit organisations)

Two-phase project: Phase 1 (1-3 years) + Phase 2 (2 years)

Partners must:

- Produce an **Action Plan**
- Set up a regional **stakeholder group**
- Participate in Interreg Europe **Learning Platform**
