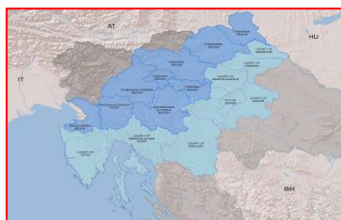

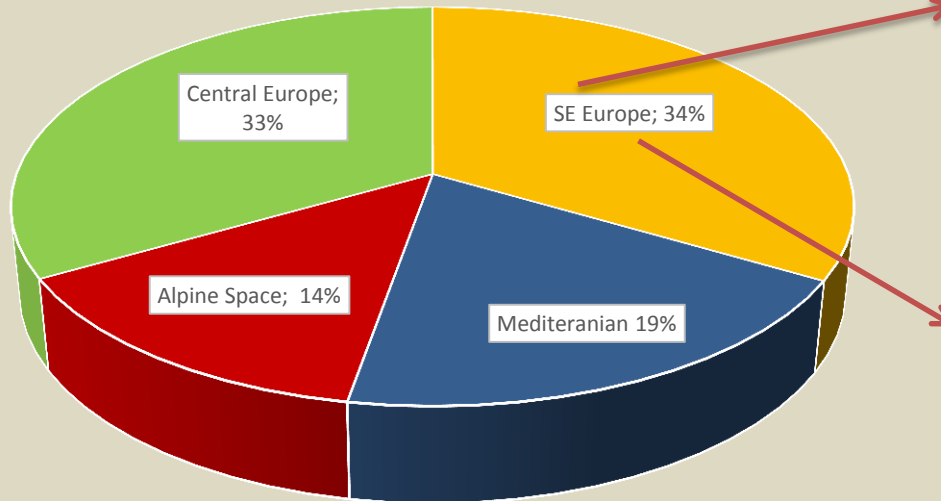

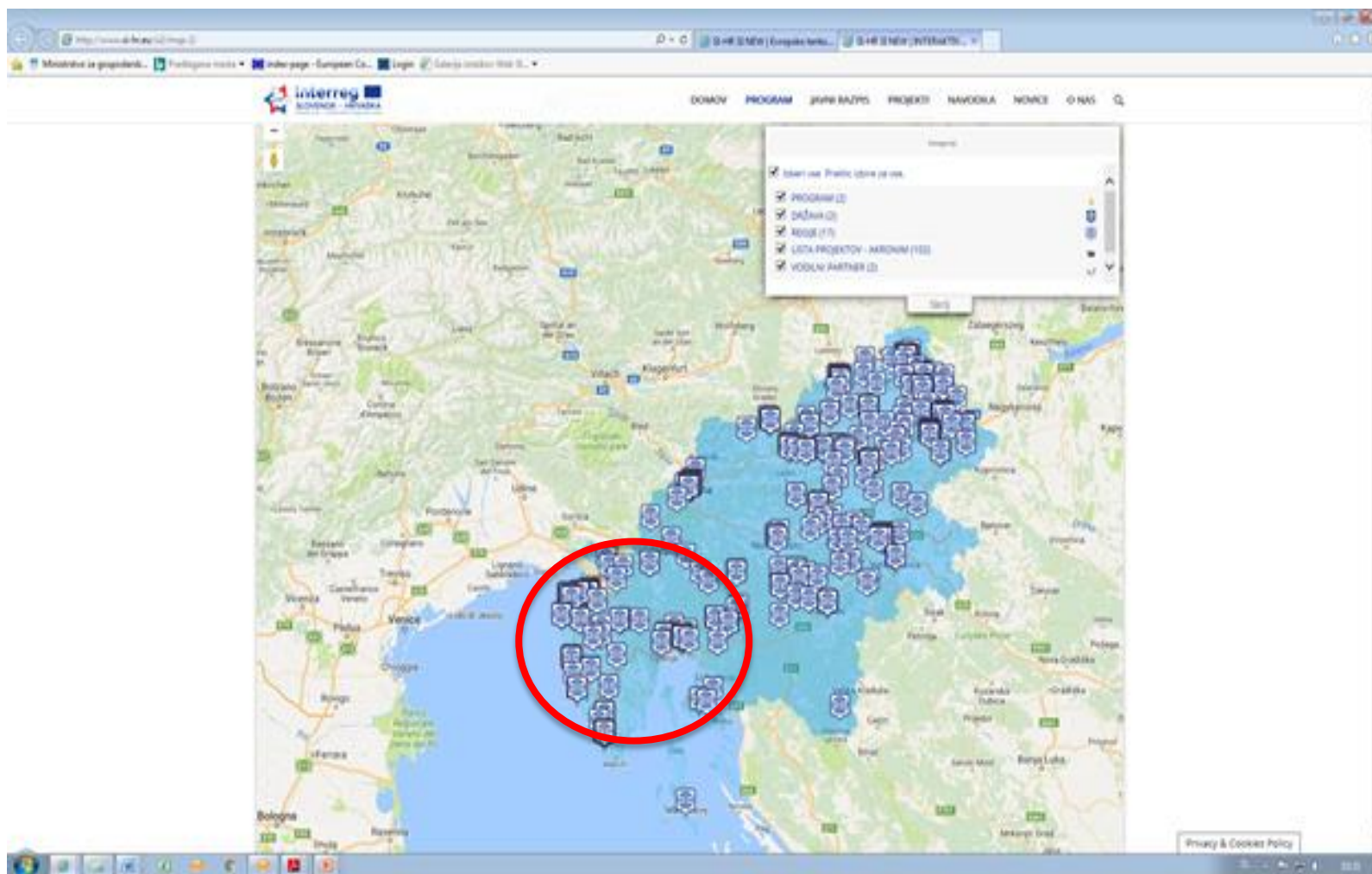

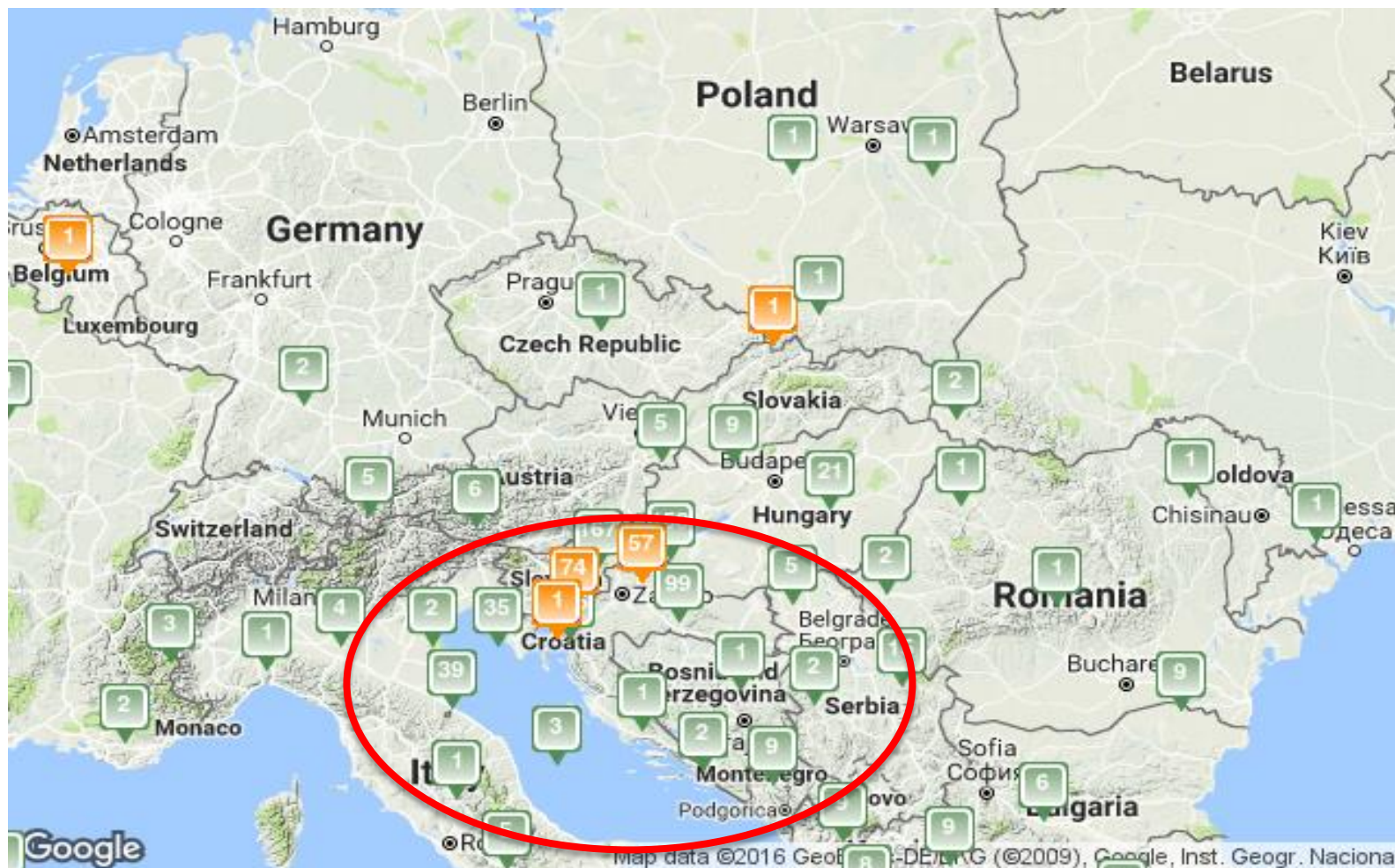


IMPLEMENTED PROJECTS 2007-2013: INTERACTIVE MAP

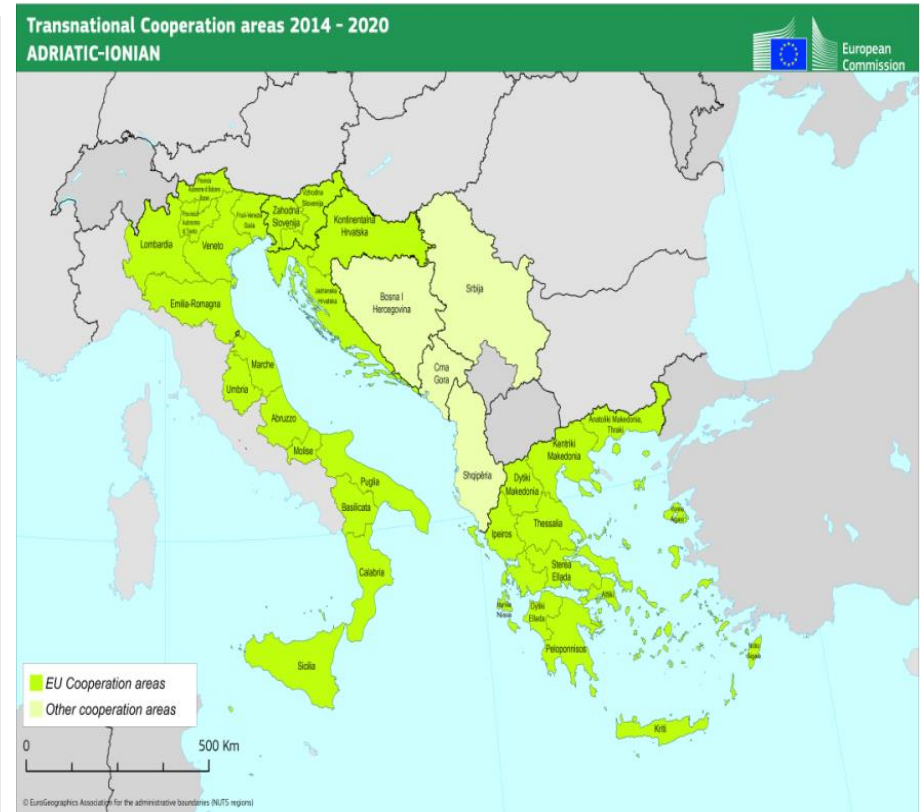
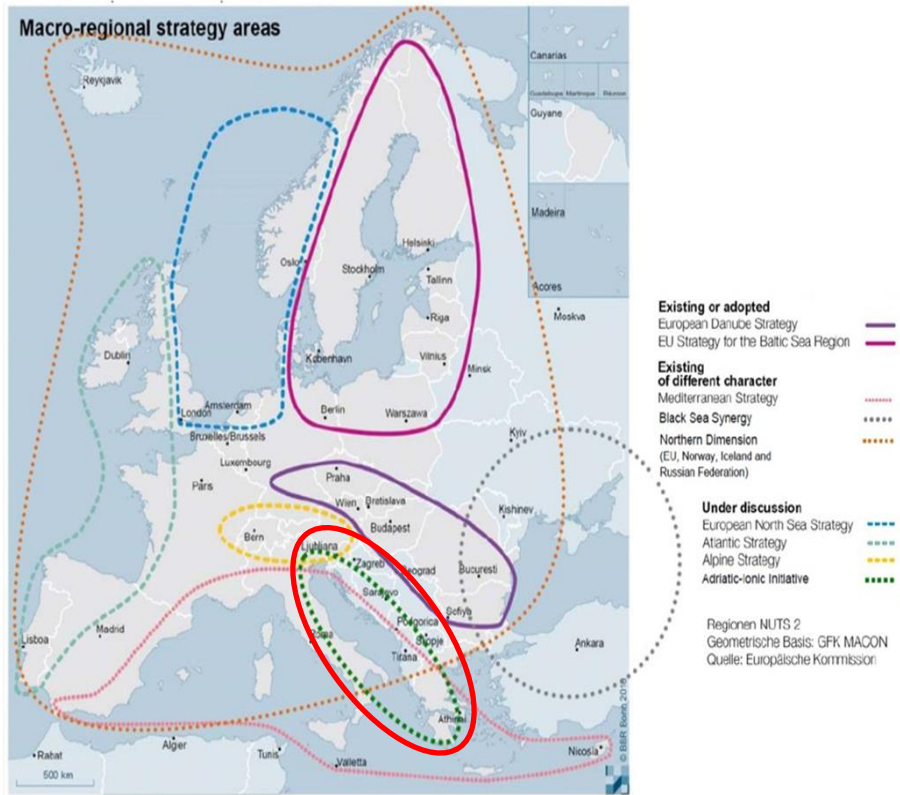

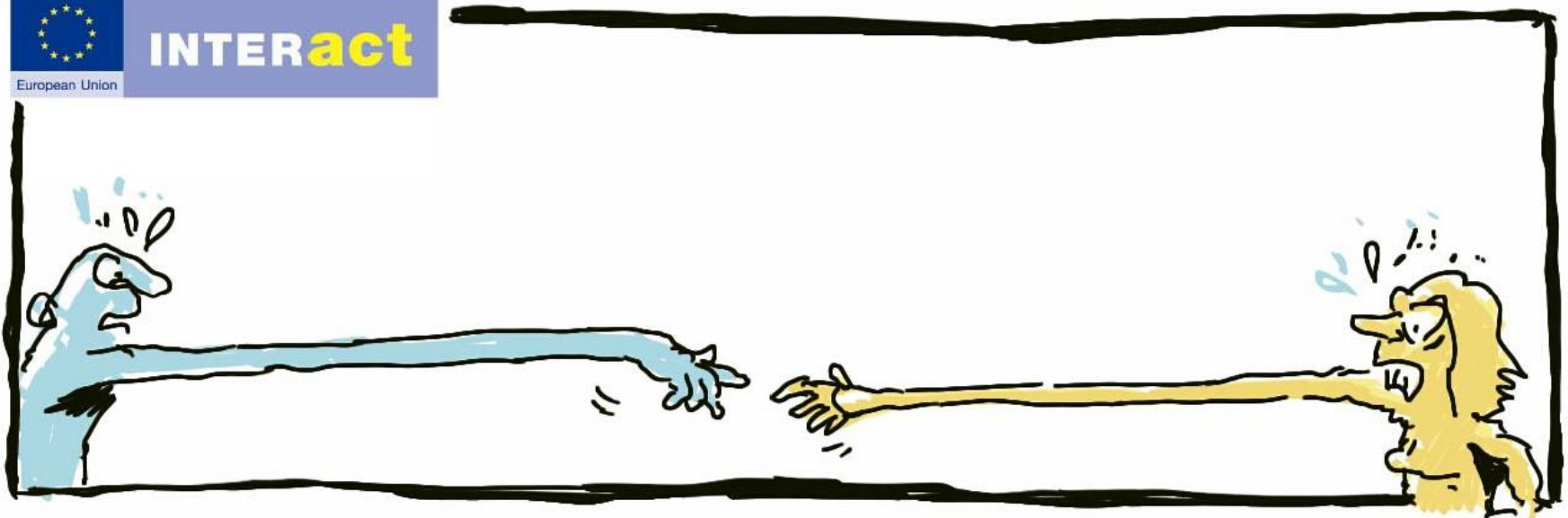
