







Secure, clean and efficient energy in H2020 - PRIORITIES



Project portfolio of RES (Energy calls 2014-2015, incl. SME instrument, EU contribution, Mio €)




















Synergies

<u>Combining funding</u> from the Framework Programme/Horizon 2020 and the ESI Funds (and/or from other sources)


Funding actions that <u>capitalise on already</u>
