




Translated into Fund-specific investment priorities

ERDF/CF: Strong commitment to low-carbon economy


- Thematic concentration requirements for TO4 exceeded by about 50%
- More than a doubling of ERDF/CF funding to TO4 compared to 2007-2013



Funding leading to benefits for people, regions and businesses




ERDF+CF allocations in EUR billion, all EU MSs Comparison 2007-2013 vs 2014-2020






Objectives:

Thematic Smart Specialisation Platforms: Rationale?

1. Implementation RIS3: what is at stake?

- Place-based innovation policy
- Bottom-up innovation driven industrial policy
- Systemic transformation
- Policy synergies can operate via regional policy
- New approach to cohesion and European integration

2. TSSP instrument for:

- regional development and cohesion focussing regional/national priorities in international VC-s
- European integration
- leveraging private investment

3. Building blocks:

- Smart Specialisation Partnerships
- Entrepreneurship discovery process at EU level
- Investment pipeline



Smart Specialisation Partnerships



- Basis of the TSSP
- Express the joint commitment to co-invest in a priority areas (leadership & ownership by motivated regions)
- Interregional Cooperation as driver for implementation of smart specialisation investment
- Political commitment: linked to RIS3 priorities
- 'Expression of interest' by 'lead-regions'= starting point for the process (scoping the thematic area of interest and synergies of partnership)
- Governance as 'joint initiative'

Conclusions



- The reformed Cohesion policy important driver for the energy investments for the 2014-2020 period
- Strong political commitment now time for delivery!!!
- Smart specialisation approach clear success but we need to move towards the next level of interregional partnerships
- Proactive approach and use of all available support strongly encouraged
