



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WHY A NEW CALL

- **Reference Sites are a critical component of the EIP on AHA Scaling-Up Strategy**
- **Demand from existing / and new Reference Sites to re-launch the process**
- **Reference Sites and Action Groups are both components of the EIP on AHA**

LEARNINGS & "WHAT'S DIFFERENT "

- Reference Site status should be the beginning (and not the end in itself) path for development
- Quadruple Helix becomes a key component / aspiration (Govt, Academia, Industry and Civil Society)
- Participation in EIP on AHA Action Groups (through Commitments)
- **Dynamic process possibility of request for reassessment after 1 year**
- **Communication Resources focused on showcasing the RSs**
- Twinning support available (2016-2017) to enable / accelerate sharing of innovative practices

WHY SHOULD I BECOME A REFERENCE SITE?


- Benefit from an international network of organisations and experts (able to share good practices and experiences)
- **Reward by recognition of "achievement"**
- Access to tools and activities that can support you in driving your strategic priorities at a regional level

WHAT YOU SHOULD NOT EXPECT

You should <u>not expect automatic EC funding as a result of gaining Reference Site status OR as a result of</u> participating in the EIP on AHA.
