European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF)



European Structural & Investment (ESI) Funds

- Budget: € 456,6 billion, 2014-2020
- Cities can spend directly 5% of the funds on urban development
- Principles for sound delivery of projects:
 - Use the technical assistance programmes
 - Leverage peer-to-peer exchanges (e.g. Covenant of Mayors, CIVITAS, Green Digital Charter, etc.)
 - Work across administrative boundaries and national borders
 - Make use of sustainable urban plans to set a strategic frame to projects



Project example: District Heating, Iasi, Romania

 Upgrading the district heating system in the Iasi municipality to EU requirements this project will rehabilitate the existing urban heating plants and heat supply networks.

Theme: Urban development

Fund: European Regional and Development

Fund (ERDF)

Total Investment: € 61.237.712

EU contribution: € 30.618.856

Horizon 2020 Lighthouse Projects

- Low energy districts
- Integrated infrastructures
- Sustainable urban mobility

Conditions

- Consortia: industry & cities
- 2-3 cities involving2-3 follower cities
- Part of ambitious urban plan
- Funding from other parts secured
- Affordable solutions





Horizon 2020 Smart City calls

- Other topics:
 - nature based solutions
 - new governance, business and financing models
 - sustainable urbanisation
- € 231.5 million foreseen for all topics, out of which € 131.5 million for lighthouse projects in 2016 and 2017

Project example: Replicate (2015 call)

- EU contribution: € 25,4 million
- Impacts
 - 58.750 m² of nZEB (696 houses)
 - Up to 90% energy savings in buildings
 - o About € 158 million invested → leverage factor 6,5
- Success factors
 - Very good balance and integration between the 3 domains
 - Very good data handling (→ collection and processing)
 - Lots of innovative and ambitious actions
 - Direct follow-up of an inegrated planning project → realisation of that plan within Replicate
- 36 partners / lighthouse cities: San Sebastian, Florence, Bristol / follower cities: Essen, Lausanne, Nilufer





Technical Assistance - ELENA

Tangible investment during project duration (leverage factor 20)

Payback clause: funding is conditional to investment

Project Development Assistance

- > 96 projects signed
- > €100 million grants
- > € 4,8 billion investments

Limited duration

Technical Assistance Grant up to 90% of eligible costs

Lyon Smart Community

- First sustainable and zero emission district
- Area of 150 ha homes, buildings and transportation



- Success factors
 - New tramway into the not yet developed district
 - Highly visible CONCERTO project in the same district
 - Investment of € 50 million for Toshiba's positive energy building block as a perfect real-world test environment
- Result: estimated € 1.2 billion private investments





Smart Specialisation Strategies (S3)

- build on national or regional innovation strategies.
- build competitive advantage by developing and matching research and innovation strengths with business needs to address emerging opportunities and market developments in a coherent manner.
- aim at avoiding duplication and fragmentation of efforts already covered by national or regional research and innovation (R&I) strategic policy frameworks, for example.

Own peer review methodology with 18 workshops in three years:

→ 53 peer reviewed regions and 16 peer reviewed countries

It has been consulted 57.000 times in 2014!
