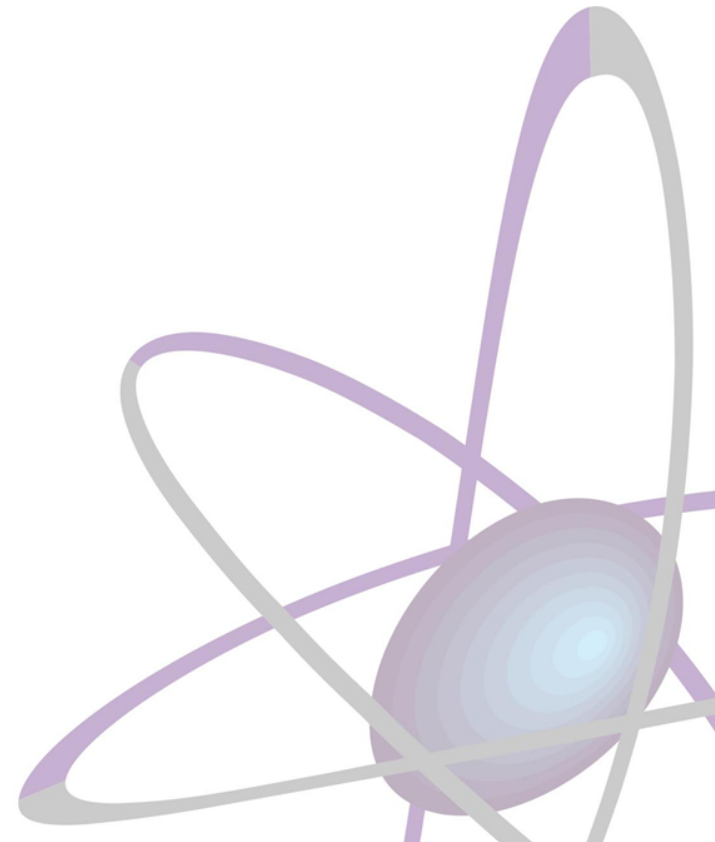
# Ex 1: Parallel Funding

EU supported projects along the value chain:



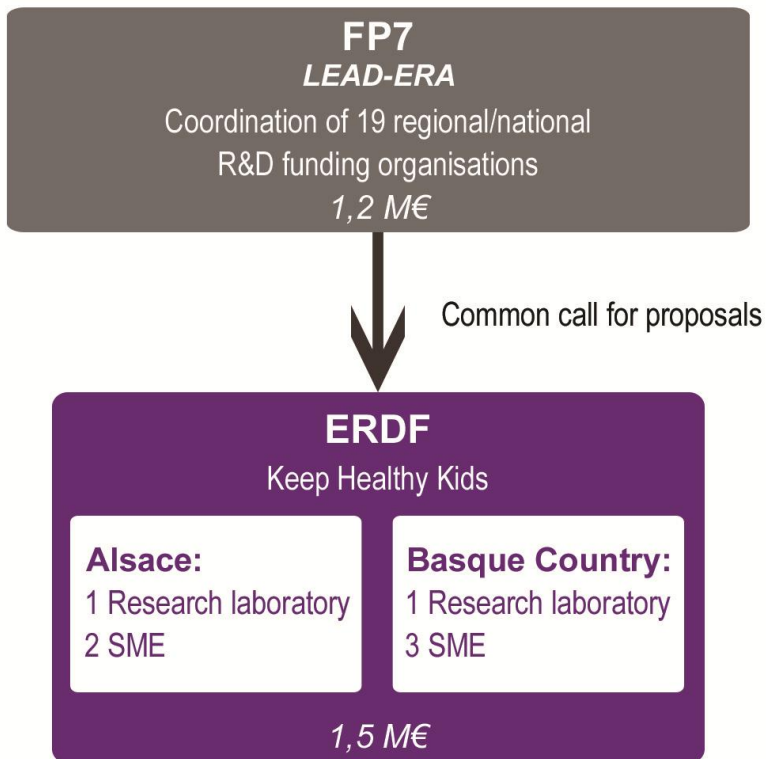
- Key to success:  
Coordinated public support + tailored information



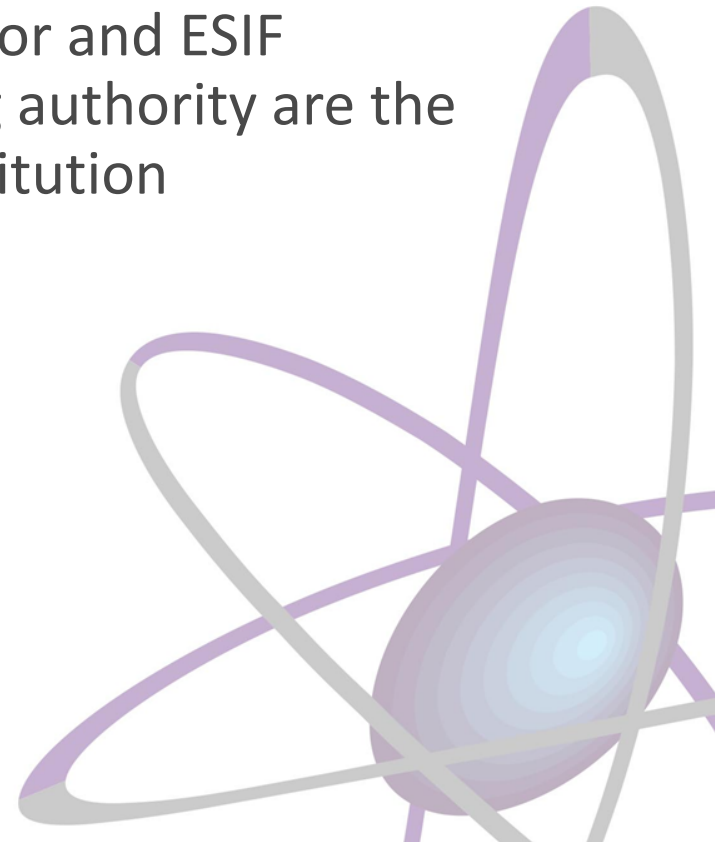
# Ex 2: Simultaneous Funding

### LEAD-ERA projects – Combining FP7 and ESIF:



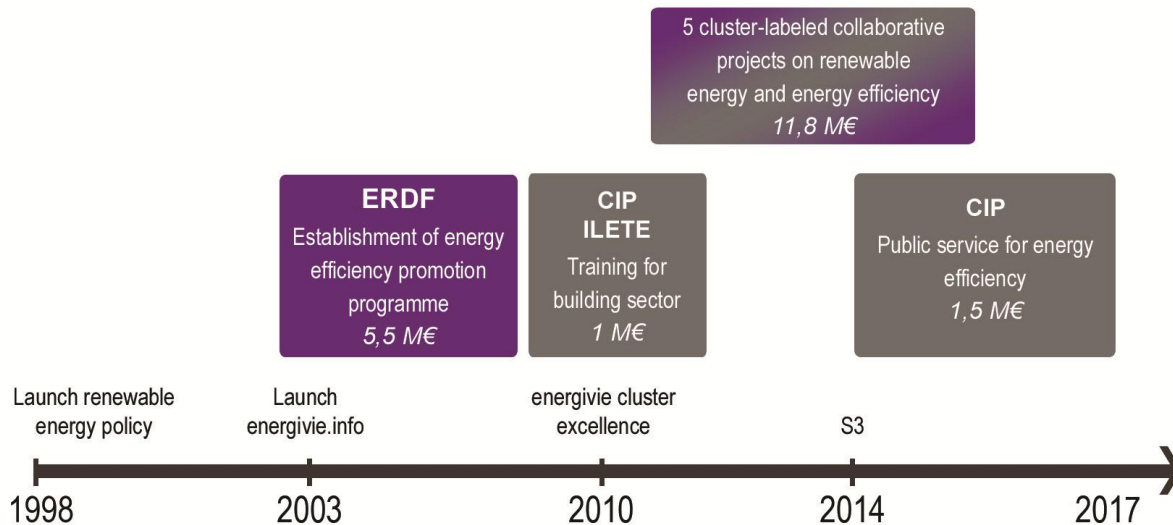
- ERA-NETs enhance regional R&I potential
- Key to success: ERA-NET coordinator and ESIF managing authority are the same institution



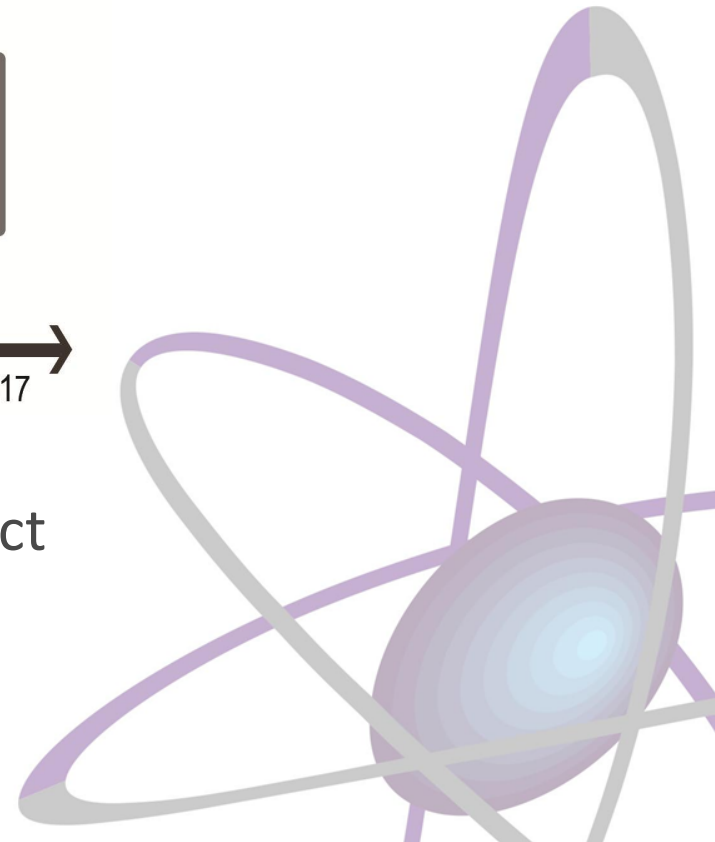
# Ex 3: Combined Funding

## Smart specialisation

### Establishment of a regional policy for energy efficiency in buildings: Political milestones and EU funding



- Synergies between funds = greater impact for regional priority initiatives
- Key to success: Coordination of ESIF managing authority with REA

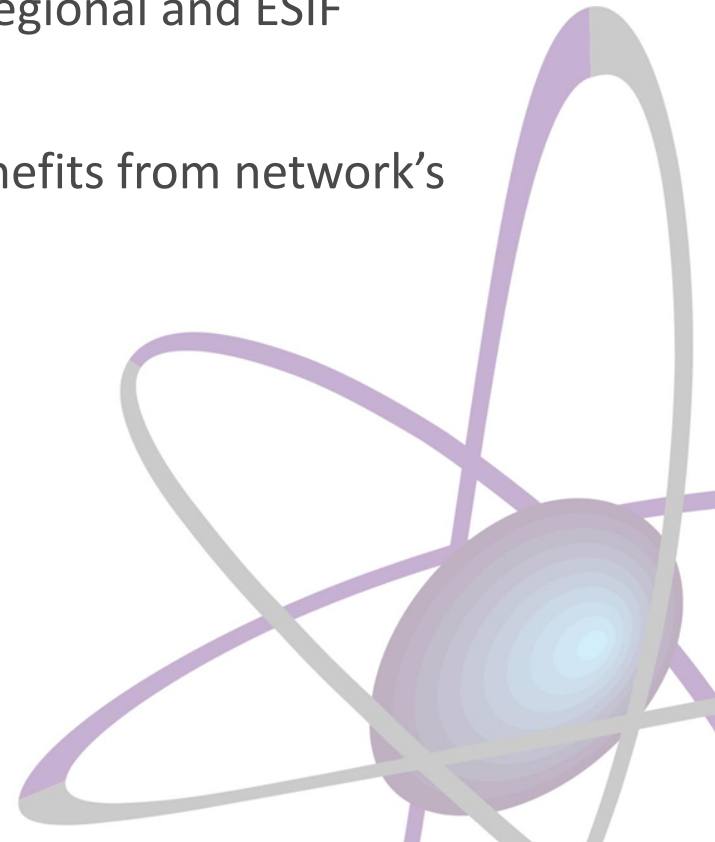


# Lessons learned

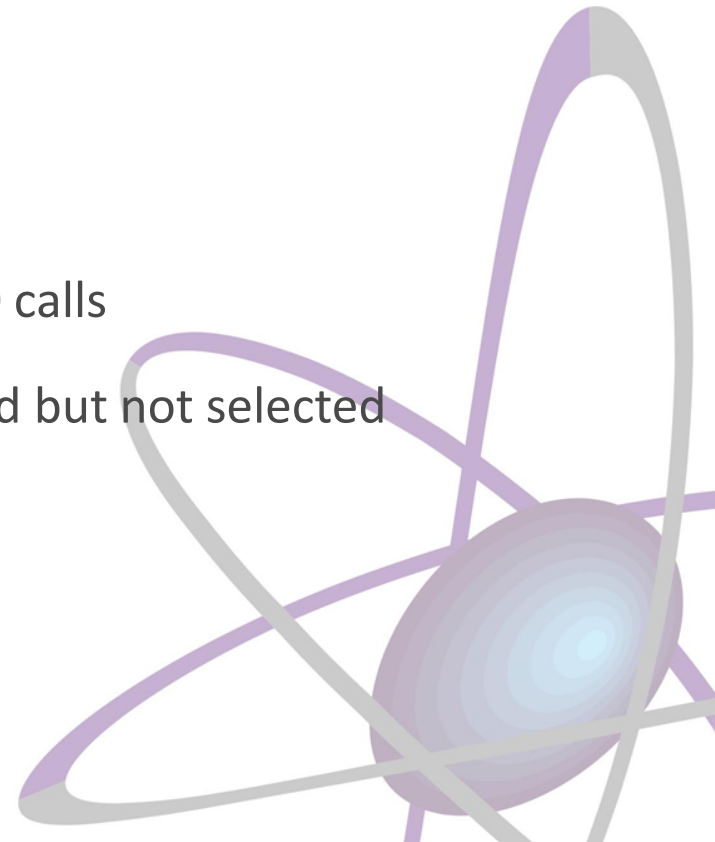
## *Wrap up*

### Key elements for successful synergies:

1. One company – coordinated initial support
2. Region uses FP7 to achieve greater impact with regional and ESIF resources – support by REA
3. Region manages ESIF and its own resources – benefits from network's knowledge on additional funding



- Key element from a regional perspective: Coordination
  - Streamline information on different funding schemes and potential beneficiaries
  - Provide complete regional support system
- How can the European Commission help?
  - provide access to regionalized results of H2020 calls
  - provide access to information on well evaluated but not selected proposals
