




- Alsace Europe Network R&I

Supporting companies through the whole value chain




 Key to success: Coordinated public support + tailored information

LEAD-ERA projects – Combining FP7 and ESIF:




- ERA-NETs enhance regional R&I potential
- Key to success: ERA-NET coordinator and ESIF managing authority are the same institution

Establishment of a regional policy for energy efficiency in buildings:




Political milestones and EU funding

- Synergies between funds = greater impact for regional priority initiatives
- Key to success: Coordination of ESIF managing authority with REA



Key elements for successful synergies:

- 1. One company coordinated initial support
- 2. Region uses FP7 to achieve greater impact with regional and ESIF resources support by REA
- 3. Region manages ESIF and its own resources benefits from network's knowledge on additional funding



Lessons learned



- Key element from a regional perspective: Coordination
 - Streamline information on different funding schemes and potential beneficiaries
 - Provide complete regional support system
- How can the European Commission help?
 - provide access to regionalized results of H2020 calls
 - provide access to information on well evaluated but not selected proposals
