Threefold approach in the EU to close the R&I Divide, spread excellence and widen the participation (in HORIZON 2020):

- Action at national/regional level (with the support of the EU Cohesion Policy)
- Action through "Widening actions" in H2020
- Synergies, in particular between H2020 and Cohesion Policy





Overview of "Widening actions" in HORIZON 2020

- Teaming for Excellence
- Twinning (institutional networking)
- ERA Chairs (bringing excellence to institutions)
- NCPs (information, communication, support)
- Policy Support Facility (support for R&I Policy design)
- COST (stimulating cross border science networks)

Budget for "Widening actions" in H2020 ~ € 800 million





Synergies under "Widening actions"

Teaming:

- R&I Strategy of the future Centre of excellence should fit in with the Smart Specialisation Strategy of the MS/region
- National/ESIF commitment needed for rolling out the future centre

Twinning

Alignment with the objectives of the Smart Specialisation Strategy of the MS/region is encouraged

ERA Chairs:

- Selected field of ERA Chair to be in line with the objectives of the Smart Specialisation Strategy of the MS/region
- Research capacity to be funded by ESIF



Creation of new (or significant upgrade of existing) Centres of Excellence in Iow performing Member States and regions;

The Partners - 2 parties in each Teaming project:

- (1) the participant organisation (**COORDINATOR**) from a <u>low</u> <u>performing</u> Member State (<u>for example</u> a research agency at national or regional level, or a regional authority);
- (2) an institution of research and innovation excellence (public or private) or a consortium of such institutions (from EU28 or AC);





Design of the action (in 2 stages):

<u>Stage 1:</u> Funding for the development of a Business Plan for the new/upgraded Centre of Excellence facilitated by a teaming process with a leading counterpart in Europe

Stage 2: Subject to the quality of the Business Plan, and a commitment of the Member State (e.g. support via Cohesion Policy Funds), the Commission may provide further substantial financial support for the first steps of implementation of the Centre.

<u>Proposals (Stage 1):</u> Need to demonstrate the long-term science and innovation strategy of the future Centre based on a SWOT analysis

<u>Proposals (Stage 2):</u> Business Plan (Stage 1 deliverable) with robust financial commitments (from national/ESIF)





Call 2014 ("Stage 1"): Business Plan for a Centre of Excellence (CoE)

Budget: € 11.85M

Call deadline: 17 September 2014

Project Size: €200.000 - €500.000 per proposal

Project Duration: 12 months

Deliverable: Business Plan of the CoE

In 2016: ("Stage 2") Start-up/Implementation of the CoE

Budget: ~ € 80-90 M Project Size: €15-20M

<u>Project Duration</u>: ∼ 5 years

<u>Funding for:</u> Substantial support for the start-up & implementation phase of the CoE (salaries, other operational and administrative costs, small equipment)

<u>Implementation:</u> Specific Grant Agreement established under a Framework Partnership Agreement (Coordination and Support Action)

Total Budget for Teaming in H2020: ~ € 270 M





Key Success Factors:

- Well-chosen, carefully structured <u>partnership</u> & strong <u>engagement</u> from both parties
- Long term vision (at least 10-15 years) & long term financial commitment nationally (at least €40-50 M) from the outset
- Coordinator: strong in project management and in mobilising national/Cohesion funding
- New CoE: Eventual autonomy in decision-making is a must for sustained excellence
- Alignment with the national/regional Smart Specialisation Strategy:
- Synergies with Cohesion Funding: Need to make appropriate conditional "space" in ESIF
 OPs to secure possible funding for Stage 2
