Length: 400 to 700 words, on average 1 page and maximum 2 pages.

Stakeholders can submit their story in English.

### Your account should include the following elements:

#### 1. Which part of the RIS3 approach does your story relate to?

It could be about stakeholders' involvement (Entrepreneurial Discovery Process), the Governance system, Monitoring and Evaluation, Interregional cooperation, Partnerships... Here are some examples of issue of interest:

- Behavioural change / production of local collective goods (platforms, support services, etc.)
- Structure of the governance setting
- Development of R&I Policy instruments (funding decisions)
- Monitoring and evaluation mechanisms
- Advantages of joining the partnerships of the Agri-food / Energy / Industrial Modernisation Thematic Platforms from the perspective of a country / region / cluster / higher education institution:

#### 4. What are the obstacles overcome thanks to the RIS3 approach? What were the solutions encountered?

- **A title**, short and catchy
- **A short quote from a policy-maker or regional stakeholders**
- **A web page link**, ideally an S3 related official URL
- **A jpg picture** (300 dpi resolution, at least 3000x 2000 pixels, with copyright information)..
