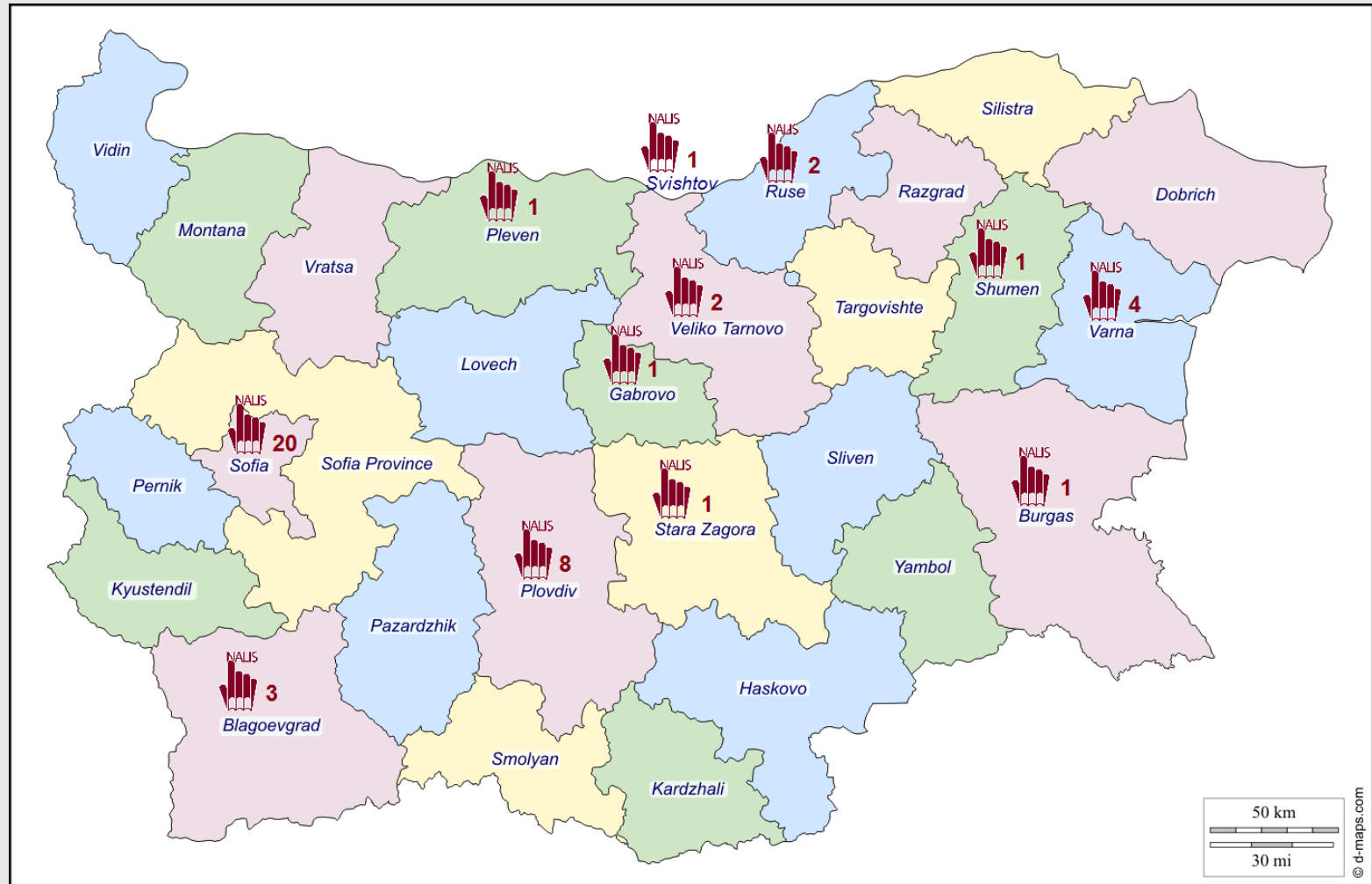


First Innovation:

NALIS Union Catalogue

- Integrated search through more than 3.5 million bibliographic records from 40 libraries, each using a **different** LIS (Library Information System);
- Controlled access to the **digital collections**.

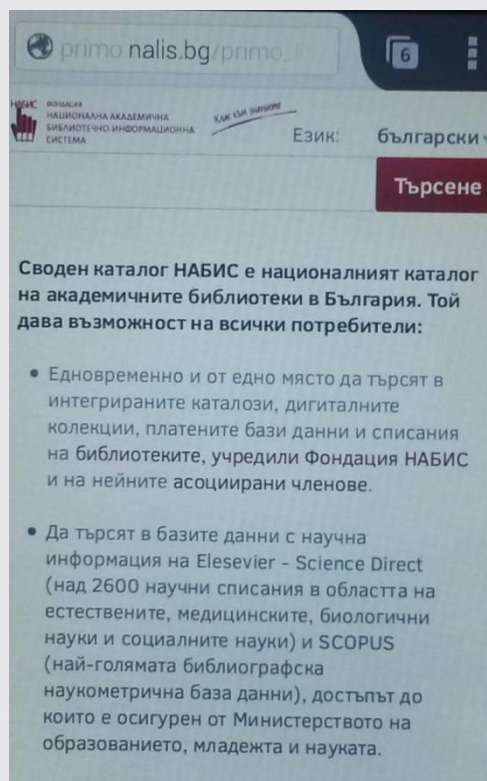

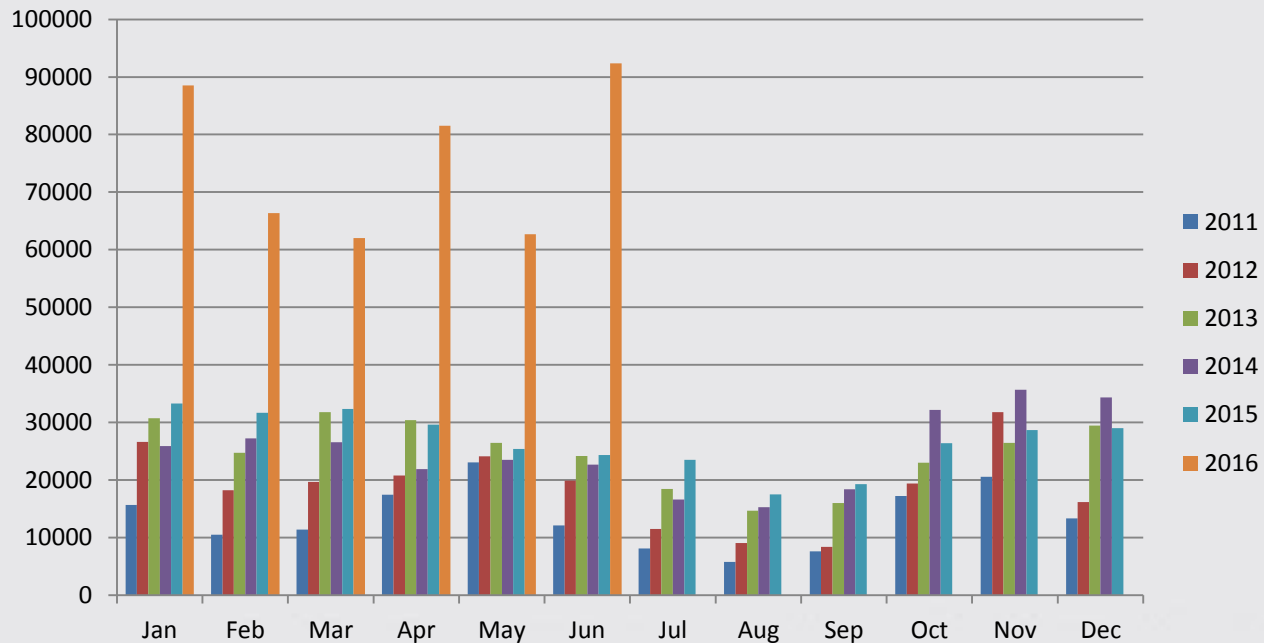

Search statistics 2011-2016



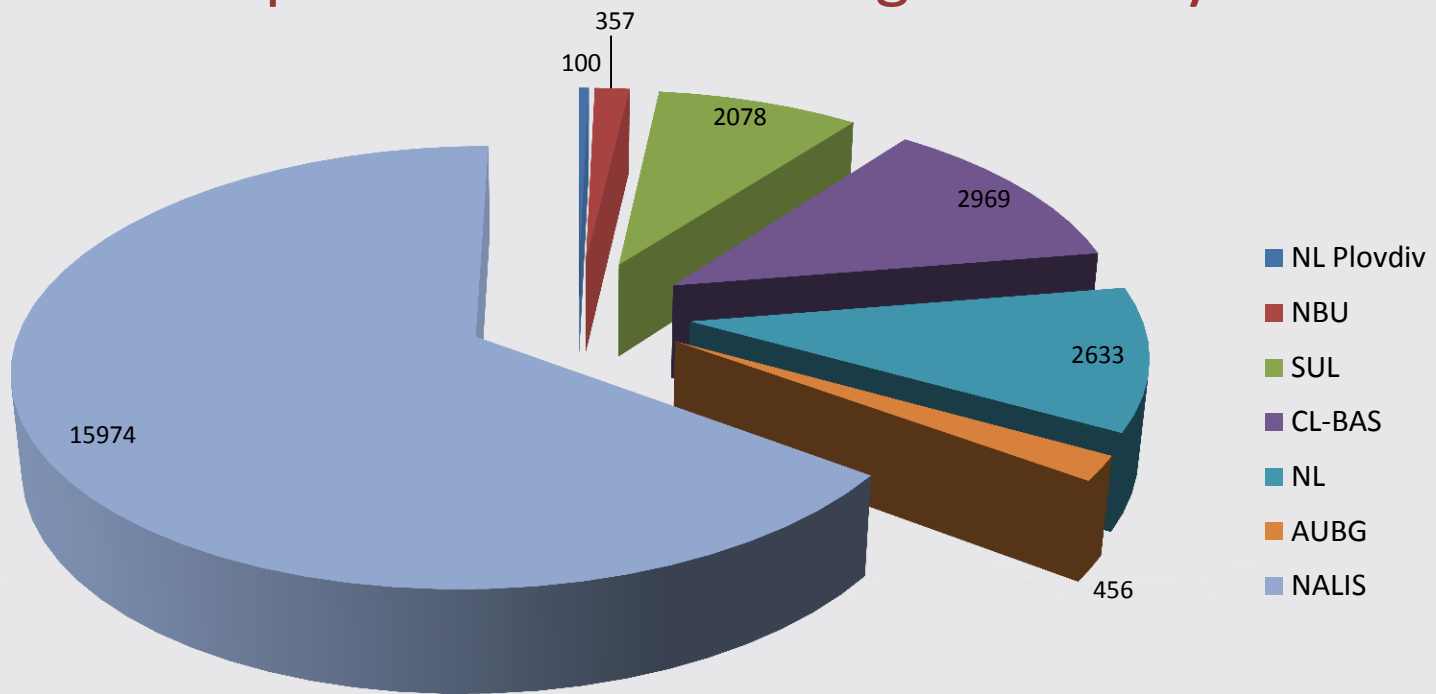
Potential:
