The Smart Specialisation Platform



- The **Smart Specialisation Platform (S3 Platform)** was put in place to assist regions and Member States in developing and implementing their RIS3 strategies
- Managed by a team established in the Territorial Development Unit (B3) of the Joint Research Centre in Seville
- Focus has moved from **earlier stages of S3** (strategy design, concept development, etc.)
 - to **implementing the strategies** (EDP, governance...but also project selection criteria, resources reaching beneficiaries, monitoring & implementation)

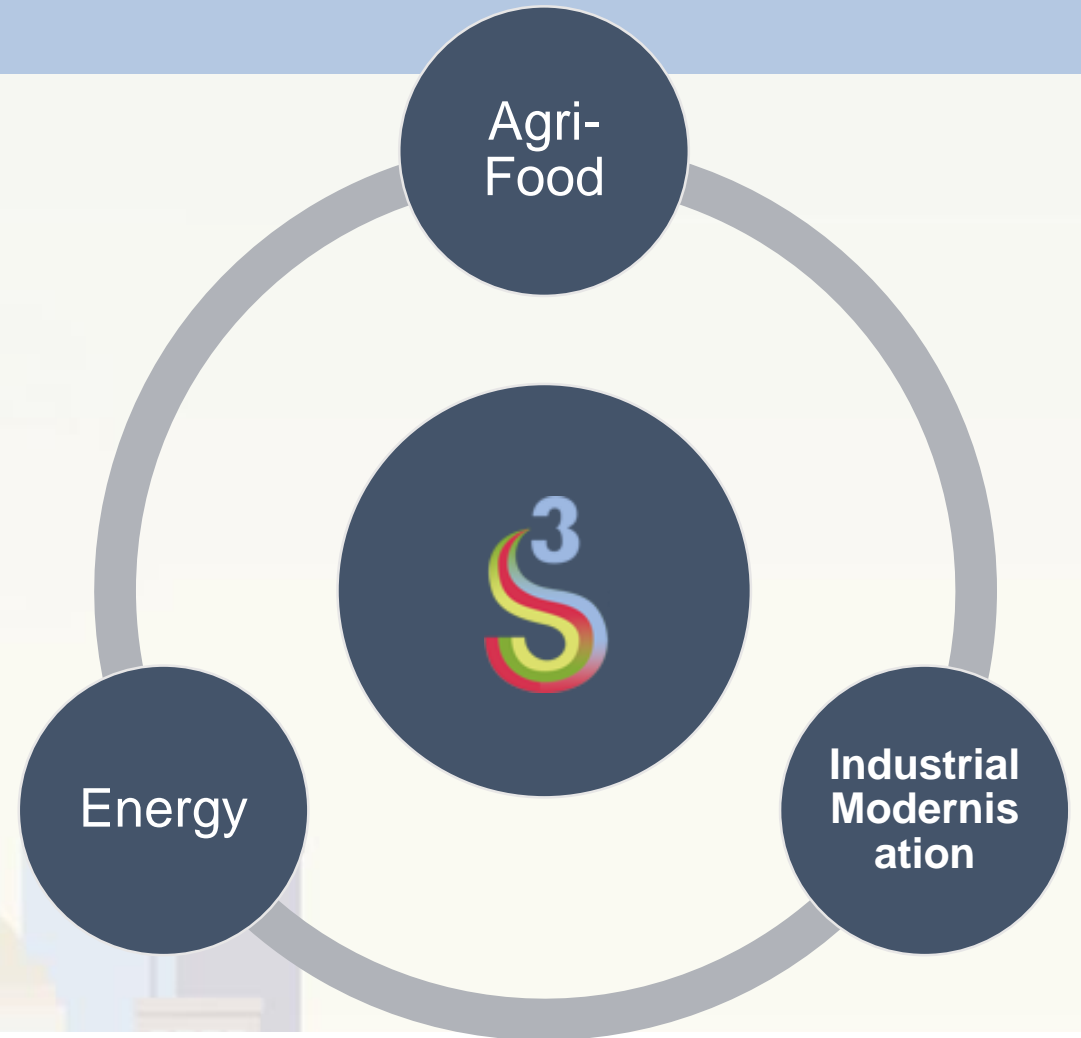
Smart Specialisation Thematic Platforms

Thematic concentration on:

- **Agri-Food**
- **Energy**
- **Industrial Modernisation**

Aim:

- To support interregional cooperation
- To provide tailored advice
- To help regions develop shared infrastructure



The S3 Platform on Agri-Food

- **Objective:** accelerate the development of joint investment projects in Agri-Food
- **Composition:**
 - **5 partnerships**
 - **49 regions and Member States** participating
- Joint action between **DG REGIO, DG AGRI, DG RTD and JRC**

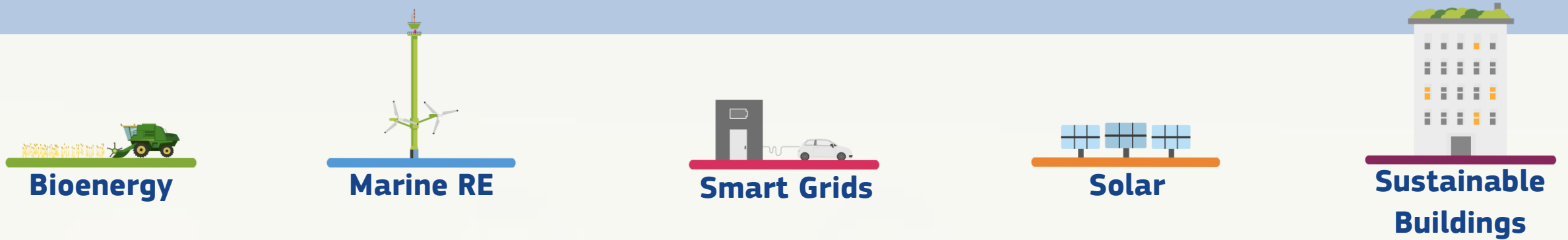

The S3 Platform on Energy



- **Energy is one of the most popular priority in S3** - 2/3 of all regions have chosen an energy-related priority in their RIS3
- **Composition:**
 - **5 partnerships + Heating & Cooling initiative**
 - **73 regions and Member States**
- Joint action between **DG REGIO, DG ENER and JRC**



The S3 Platform on Industrial Modernisation

- The Steering Committee of lead regions governs the S3P Industrial Modernisation
- **18** partnerships
- **85** participating regions and Member States
- Joint action between **DG REGIO, DG GROW and DG RTD and JRC**

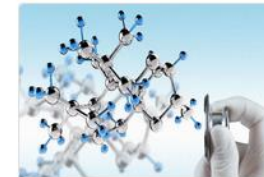

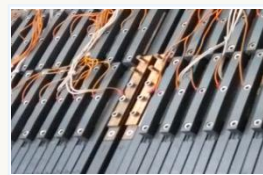

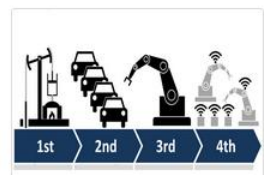
