

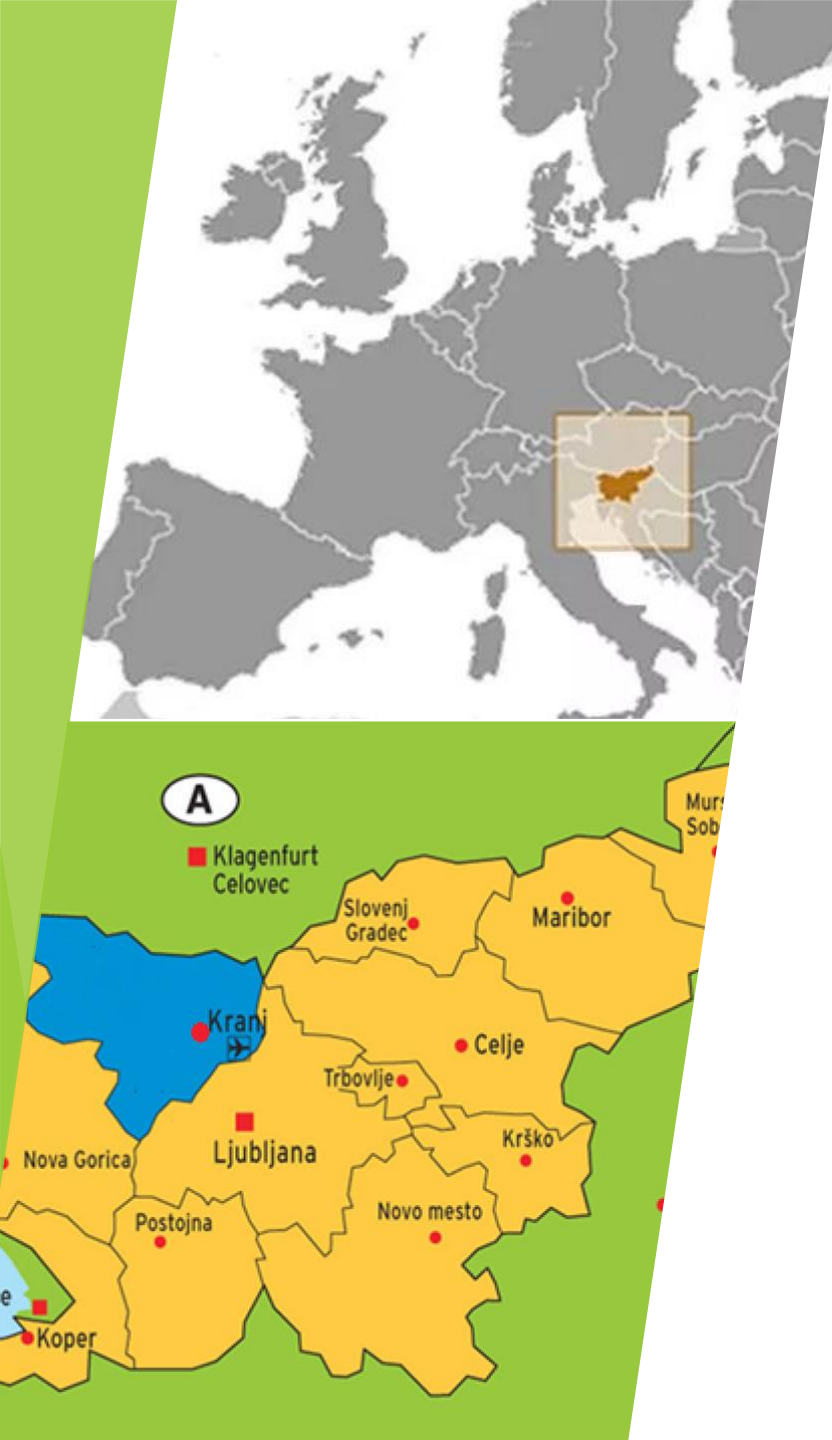

- ▶ Covering an area of Gorenjska region, 18 municipalities.
- ▶ We consult municipalities and companies:
 - ▶ on energy management,
 - ▶ preparation of documentation for tenders,
 - ▶ preparation of documents required by law,
 - ▶ use of Renewable Energy Sources,
 - ▶ public private partnership,
 - ▶ implementation of European projects.
- ▶ LEAG assists local institutions in planning projects to reduce energy consumption and maximise energy efficiency.

- ▶ The key innovative aspect of the project is its multidisciplinary approach in the frame of the sustainable construction sector, including financial schemes, capacity building, innovation, awareness raising and combating against energy poverty, amongst others.

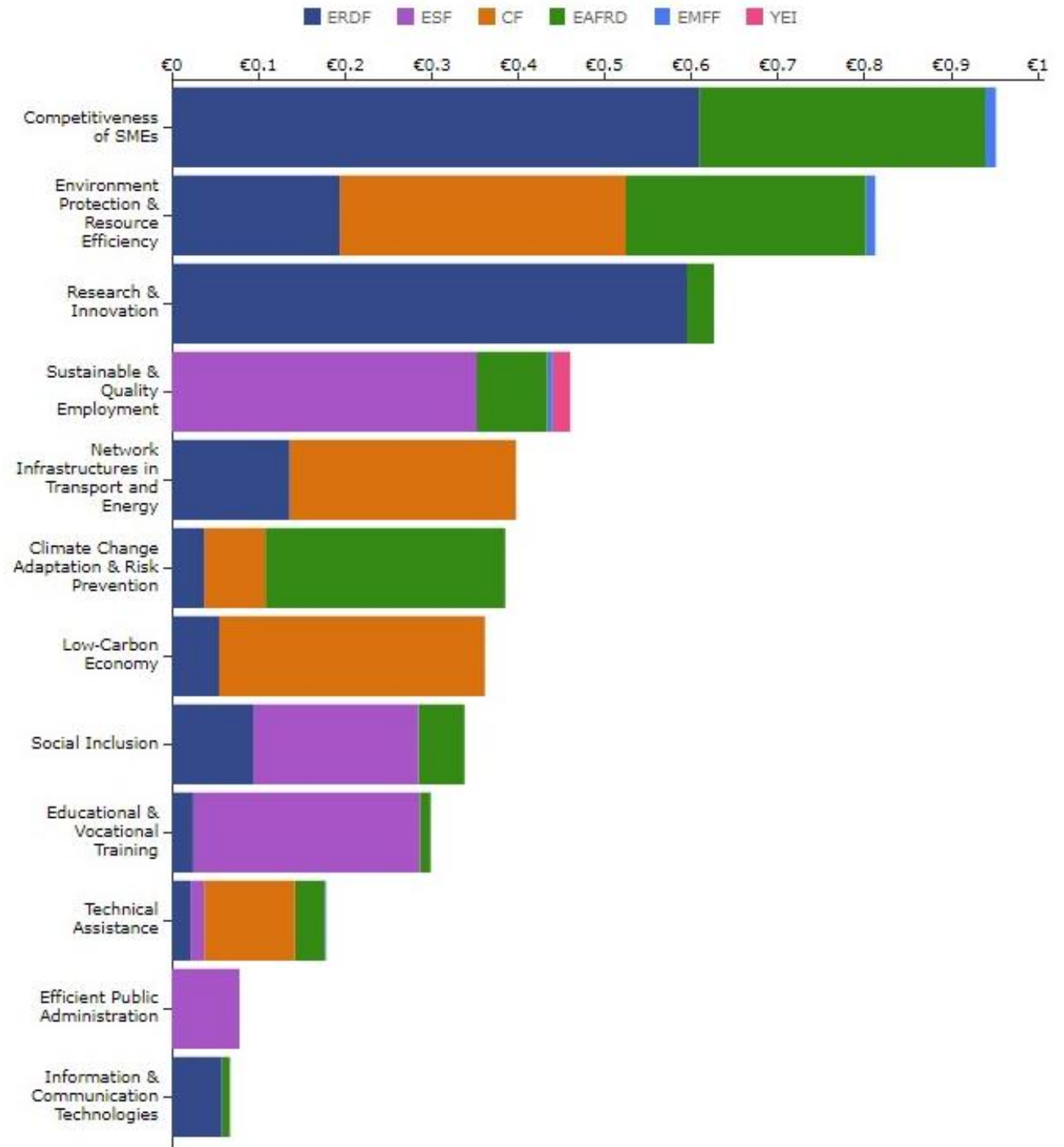

ESIF funding

- ▶ Slovenia, through 3 national programmes, benefits from ESIF funding of EUR 3,9 billion. This represents an average of 1.880 euro per person from the EU budget over the period 2014-2020.

SID Bank - Fund of Funds

- 2017 November - established
- 2018 September - first loans for SME
- 2019 May - loans for financing projects for energy renovation of public buildings (EE)

- ▶ The total amount of funds for financial instruments for the eligibility period up to 2023 amounts to EUR 253 million (European Cohesion Fund).
- ▶ FI are implemented on the basis of the Fund's fund, which is funded by the SID Bank:
 1. through financial intermediaries that will be chosen in accordance with the rules of public procurement,
 2. directly by itself.

Financing in the scope of European cohesion policy

▶ SMEs

- ▶ Financing for sustainable economic growth and development, investments in innovation and current operations through debt financing in four areas: research, development and innovation, small and medium-sized enterprises, energy efficiency and urban development.
- ▶ Loans to finance research, development and innovation (RDI)
- ▶ Micro-loans for SMEs (SME micro)

▶ Large enterprises

- ▶ Based on European Cohesion Policy funds and funds from financial intermediaries, we provide financing for sustainable economic growth and development, investments in innovation and current operations through debt financing in the areas of research, development and innovation, energy efficiency and urban development.
- ▶ Loans to finance research, development and innovation (RDI)

▶ Municipalities and the public sector

- ▶ Energy efficiency
- ▶ Based on European Cohesion Policy funds and leverage funds, affordable long-term loans are available to the public sector and energy service companies (ESCO) for the complete energy renovation of public buildings.

▶ Urban development

- ▶ Based on European Cohesion Policy funds and leverage funds, affordable long-term loans are available for municipal projects in the area of urban development.

SID Bank - Fund of Funds

Loans for energy renovation of public buildings (EE)

- ▶ For energy renovation of public buildings that are owned and used by public sector entities.
- ▶ For the projects before the application was launched, the project has already begun but has not yet been completed.
- ▶ **38,5 mio EUR** (25 mio EUR ECF; 13,5 mio EUR SID Bank)
- ▶ A loan in the amount of € 100,000 to € 15,000,000.
- ▶ Funding up to 100% of eligible costs with VAT included.
- ▶ The interest rate equal to the sum of the reference interest rate:
 - ▶ of the 6-month EURIBOR, which is calculated from SID Bank's assets (37,5% min) + fixed premium 0 % (62,5% max ECF).
- ▶ Loan age ranging from 5 to 25 years.
- ▶ Until the funds are available until 31.12.2023.
