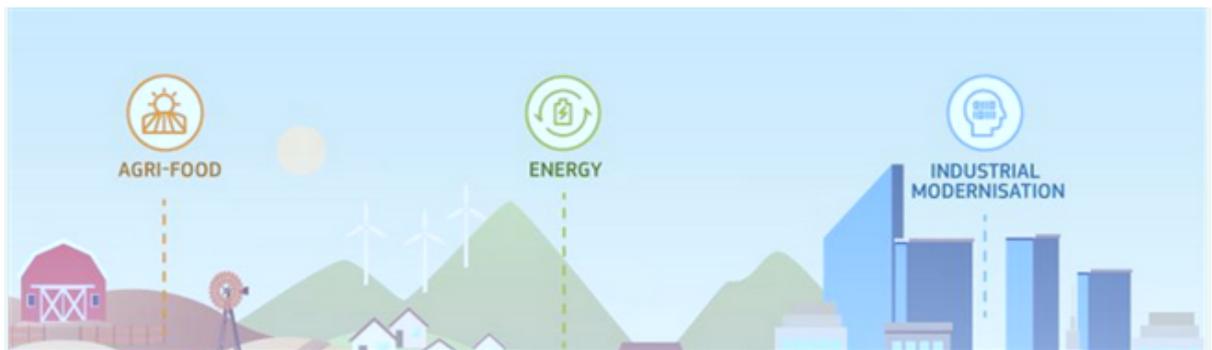

I. Management report

Please provide the executive summary of the objectives of your partnership

Reconciling better health / healthy ageing with growth opportunities for healthcare industries (and most notably SMEs) is the main objective of the previous Vanguard project and subsequent Industry Driven Initiative ESTHER (Emerging and Strategic Technologies for Healthcare). The Medtech thematic group started in May 2016 gathering Regions, RTOs and clusters in the frame of the ESTHER / VANGUARD initiatives. In December 2016, a scoping note was written and ESTHER partners applied on the S3 platform. Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes Region is leading this Medtech partnership. Since September 2017, the Medtech platform is supported by ReConfirm initiative for developing innovative interregional projects, so called "investment protocols". A first mapping of competencies has been driven in 2017, completed and consolidated by Reconfirm in 2018. Reconfirm provides support to work on the animation of the partnership and help the group to define interregional innovative project / pilot definition and plan investments projects. MedTech partnership activities are centred on the development of the project identified along its activities, providing also the opportunity to partners to raise awareness around medical technologies assets and initiatives open for collaboration.
