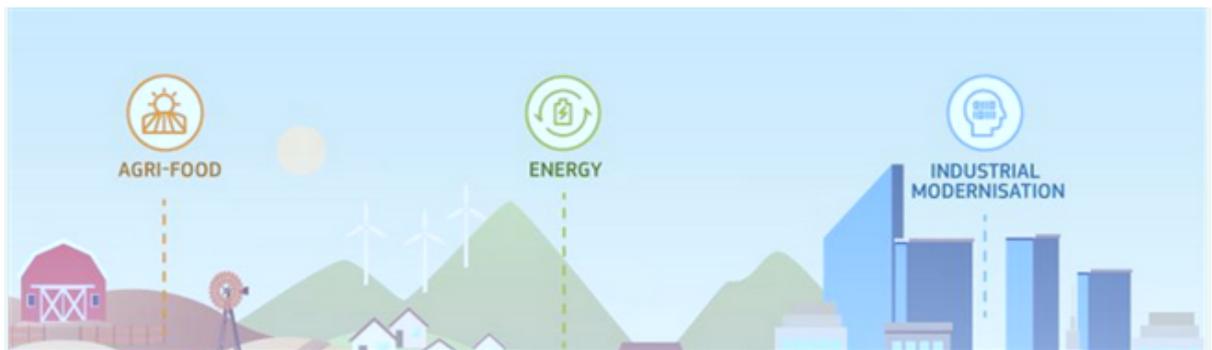

Personalised medicine

I. Management report

Please provide the executive summary of the objectives of your partnership

The development of personalised medicine (PM), stratified or precision medicine is an evolution that cannot be stopped anymore. PM is strongly technological driven and will induce a transformation of how health and well-being are approached and medicine is being implemented.

The convergence of knowledge on what determines health and disease or how the process of ageing is determined, with digital technologies and access to data opens a huge potential to develop new applications to improve general health, wellbeing, and will make preventive medicine reality.

The sensitivity of new diagnostics, access to omics data and the acknowledgement that early detection is often crucial, is blurring the boundaries between health and disease. Chronic diseases, often linked to changes in general life styles and increasing of the average age of the population are putting the healthcare systems under increasing pressure. The development of PM will not only support the increase of healthy life years, it will also secure the sustainability of our healthcare systems.

The partnership was established to realise the potential of personalised medicine. This partnership will be complementary to the thematic platform on Medical Technologies and will bring the agenda to implement personalised medicine to the next level.

Innovative results

Initial Mapping has been finalised.
The data project has been submitted to the TAF services and was selected for advice.

Not yet realistic to have tangible socio-economic impacts expected yet, other than the broad lines in the expression of interest, i.e. contribute to better health and wellbeing, sustainability of healthcare systems, preventive medicine.

Additional results obtained from working with other partnerships under the thematic S3 Platforms (specific examples)

Contacts are made with the S3 partnership on medical technologies and on Sport to identify complementarities and avoid overlap of the initiatives and align agendas.
Contacts with consortium around Tuscany, Catalonia, Andalusia, Estonia, Lithuania to discuss on possible partnering in a data project to align with the 1-million genomes project.

Evaluation of the involvement of relevant business sector (clusters, SMEs, business associations, chambers of commerce, Digital Innovation Hubs (DIHs), etcetera) in the Partnership activities (specific examples)

The regional delegations represent different actors, including 3 cluster organisations (Flanders.bio, DSPValley, bioPmed Piedmonte), regional development agencies (Oost NL, Capital region DK, NE - RO) an open innovation community (Brightlands Maastricht Health Campus, a joint triple helix initiative and Slovenian Innovation hub (SIS), an industry ambassador (Janssen Pharmaceutica), SMEs interested (Anthleron); a regional representation offices (Extremadura, Oulu).
Representation from research institutions (VIB, VITO, Maastricht University). Since October 2018 also EIT Health is a partner in S3P4PM.
EIP-AHA members have expressed interest in the partnership activities.

Evaluation of whether the level of inter-regional cooperation is sufficient to potentially provide practical and relevant socio-economic impacts (specific examples)

The interest in the activities of S3P4PM continues. We can connect with EIT-health Innostars regions through the activities of SAPHIRE, the H2020 CSA under ICPeMed on personalised medicine in regions. However, many interested partners find it difficult to get engagement of their regional authorities. Participating regions have shown an enthusiastic and strong drive to look over regional borders and find possible partnerships in an inter-regional context.

New activities

Involvement of regions from EU13 Member States in the Partnership, in particular with respect to scoping, mapping and/or matchmaking. In addition, justification should be provided if no EU13 regions are involved

Since Slovenia joined the partnership another EU 13 region, Nord-Est (RO) has joined the S3P4PM partnership. EIT Health, which has EIT Innostars under its umbrella, joined the partnership in October. EIT Innostars has as a main goal to reach out to EU-13 regions. In addition, a CSA on personalised medicine (Securing Adoption of Personalised Health in Regions - SAPHIRE) with EIT Innostars as partner has started on the 1st of December 2018. The CSA has as one of its objectives to reach out to 'remote and sparsely' populated regions, which we interpreted as the regions with less innovation power and includes EU-13 regions. As Flanders is coordinating SAPHIRE, we think that we can align the S3 strategy and the CSA goals.
